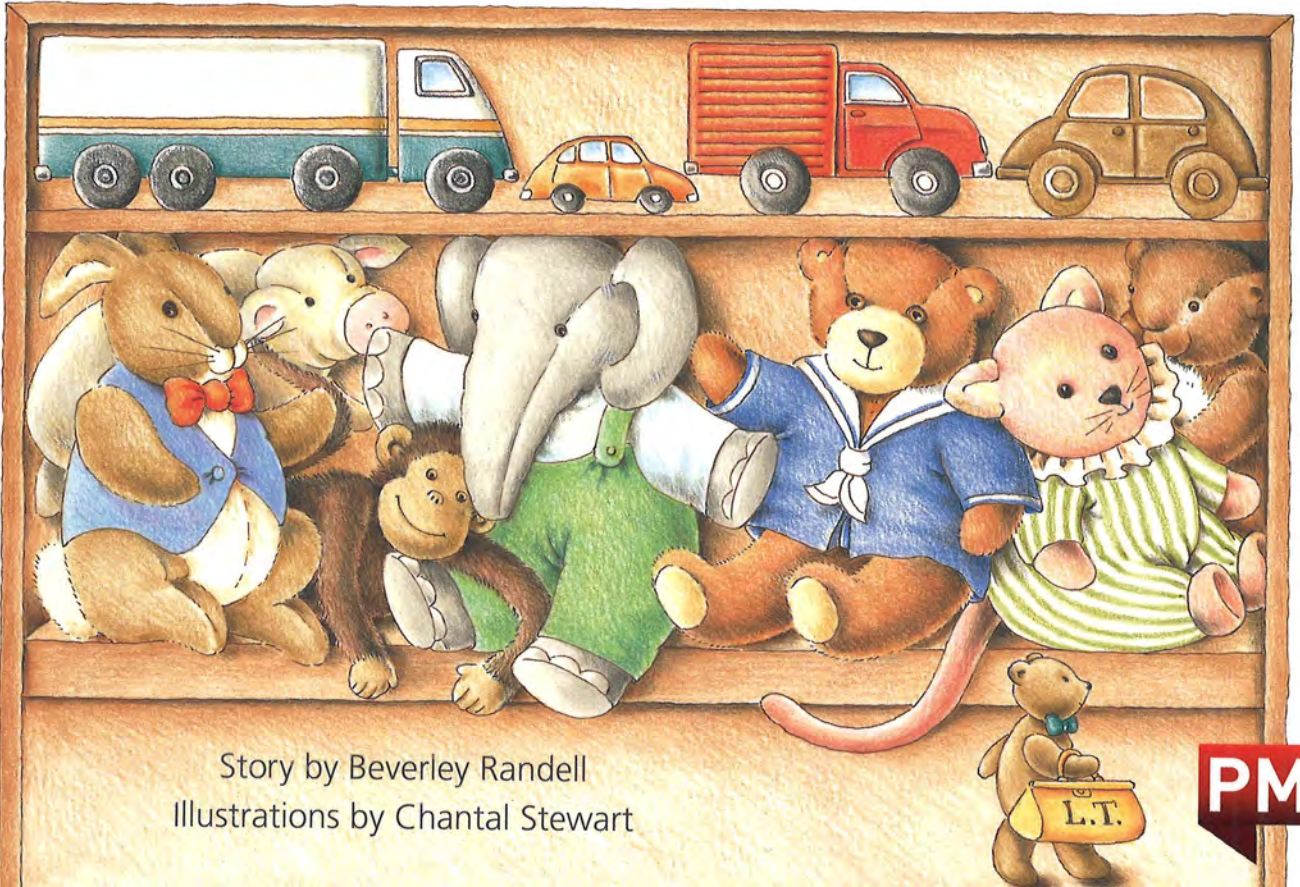

Key Teaching Points

Look closely at the illustration on page 3. Discuss the reason why Little Teddy must search for a new home. Encourage students to justify why the mouse cage and the rabbit hutch were not suitable homes for Little Teddy.

Key Questions

Where did Little Teddy find a good home? (*Literal*)

Why were the letters L.T. on Little Teddy's bag? (*Inferential*)

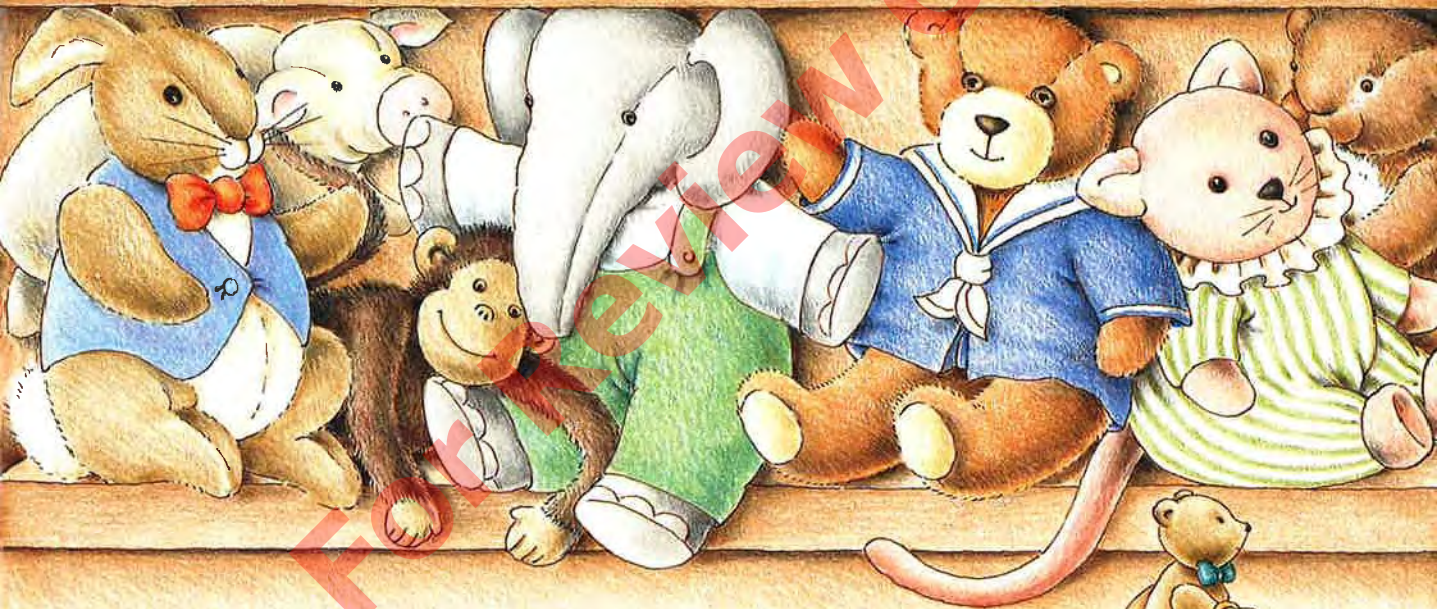

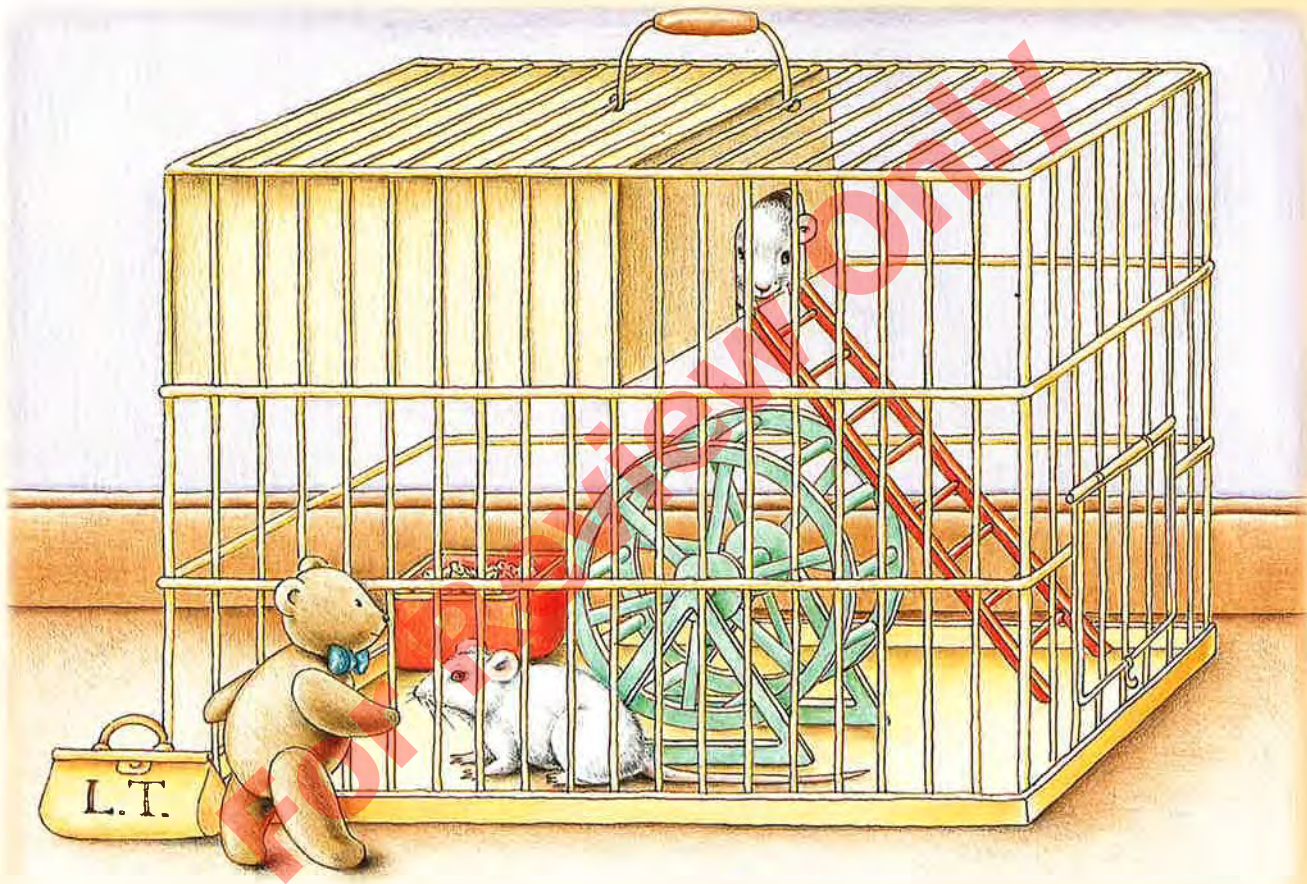
