One sentence on one line. Four words.

Key Teaching Points

Picture Discussion

Read the title to students, running your finger smoothly under the words. Talk about the photograph. Discuss what the children are using to draw their picture of Dad.

Identify each feature the children draw, and find the word in the sentence.

Concepts About Print

Explain briefly why the word Dad has an additional 's'. Read each sentence aloud with students.

Notice that the verb changes from goes to go for plural nouns.

Key Questions

What were the children doing? (Literal)

Why did the children use chalk to draw the picture of Dad? (Inferential)
