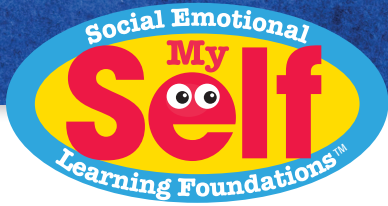

How to Read This Book with Children
