■ **aircraft** (n.) any vehicle that can fly and carry goods or passengers



■ **archaeologist** (n.) a person who studies objects belonging to ancient times



■ **coding** (n.) a system of computer programming instructions



■ **edit** (v.) to prepare a photograph, movie, book, etc. by deciding what to include and by removing mistakes



■ **lifeguard** (n.) a person who works at a beach or a swimming pool to rescue people who are in danger in the water
