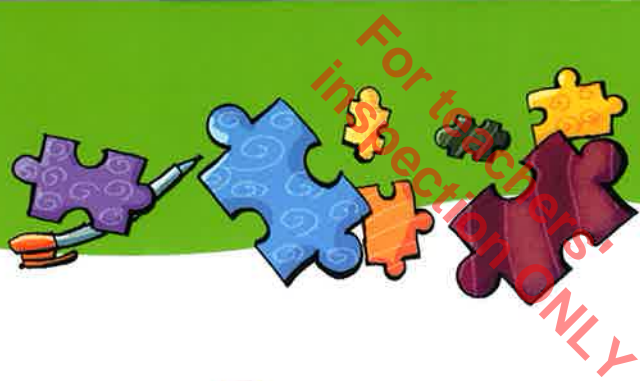

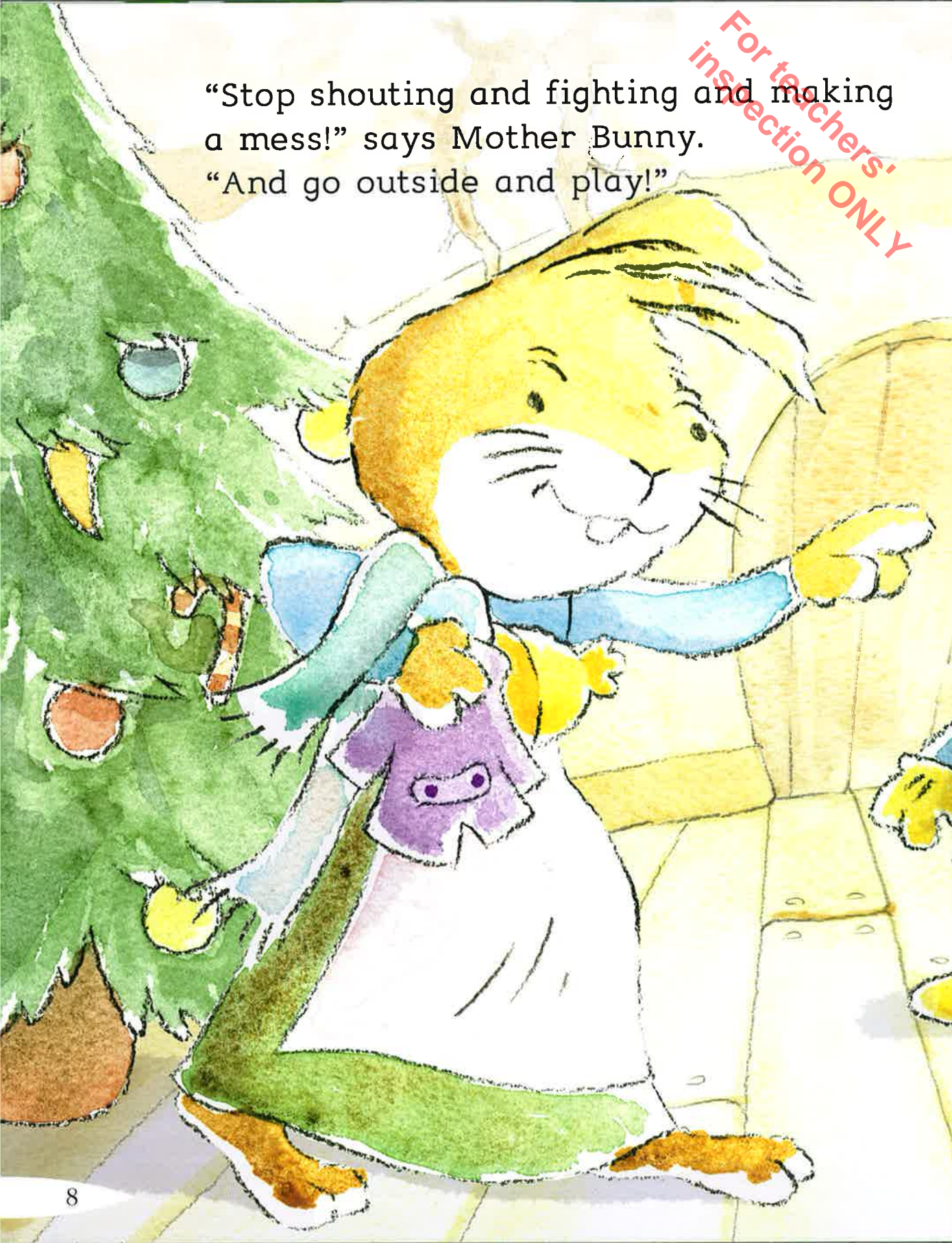


Point to the bunnies.

"And you've got my boots," says Betsey.

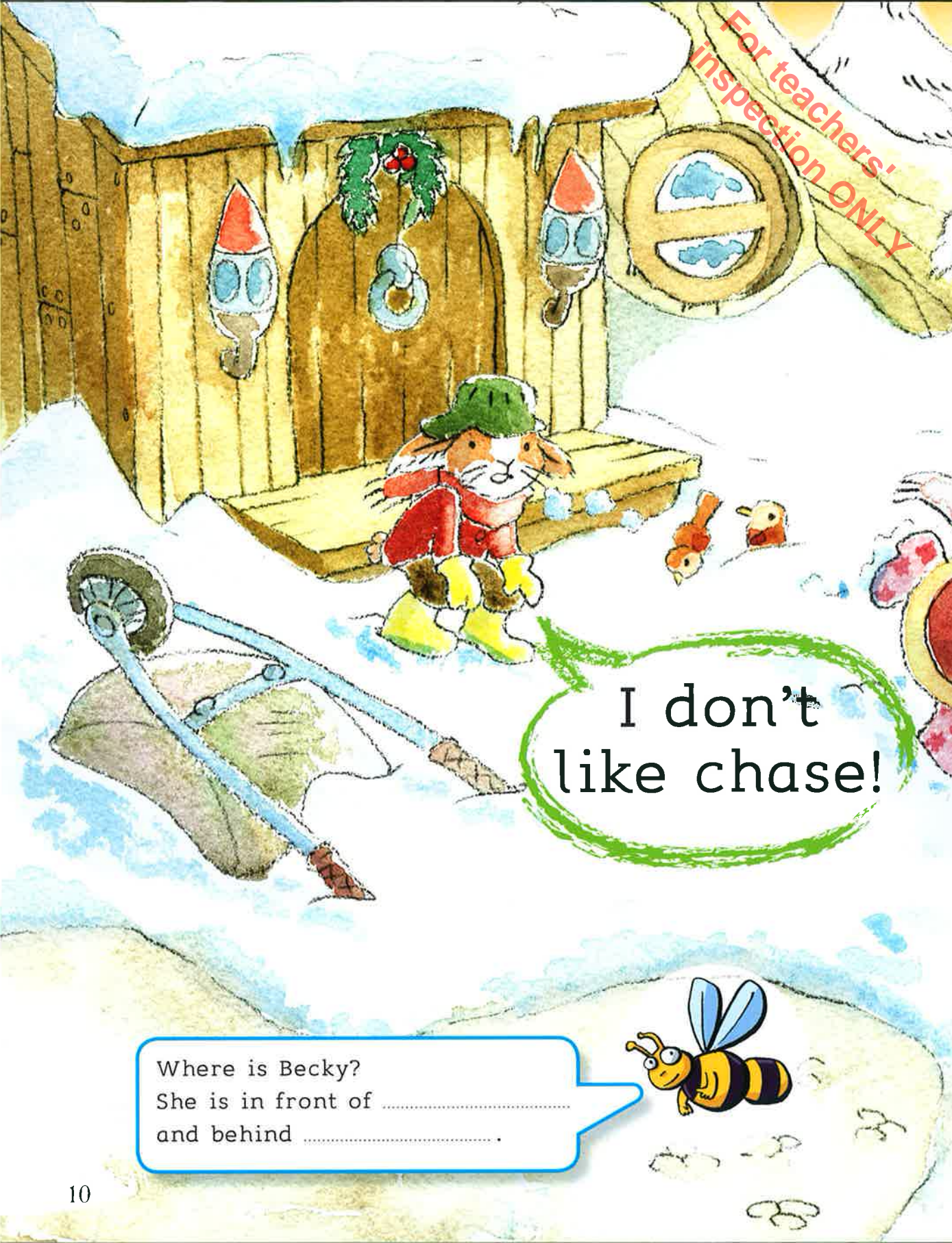
"I can't find my hat, or my coat, or my gloves, or my boots or my scarf," says Barney, the baby bunny.

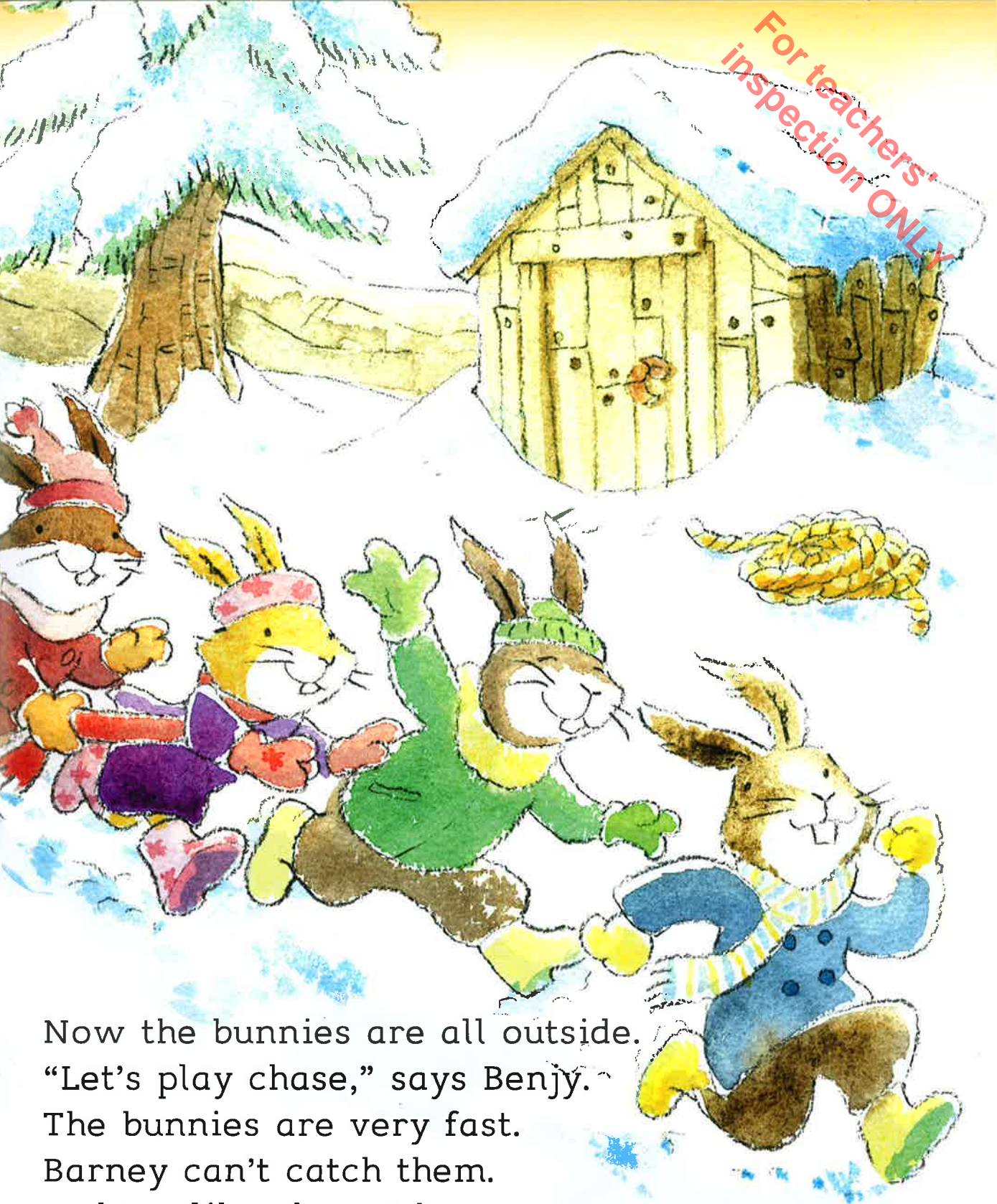

1 Draw your hand on green paper. Cut out the hand print.



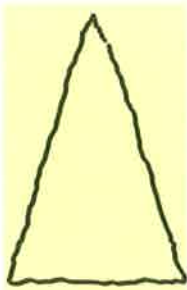
2 Write a Christmas greeting on your print.

- Merry Christmas

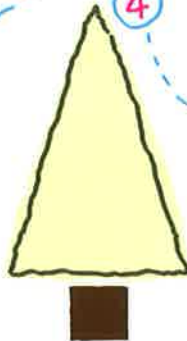

Cut a rectangle of brown paper. Glue it under the triangle.

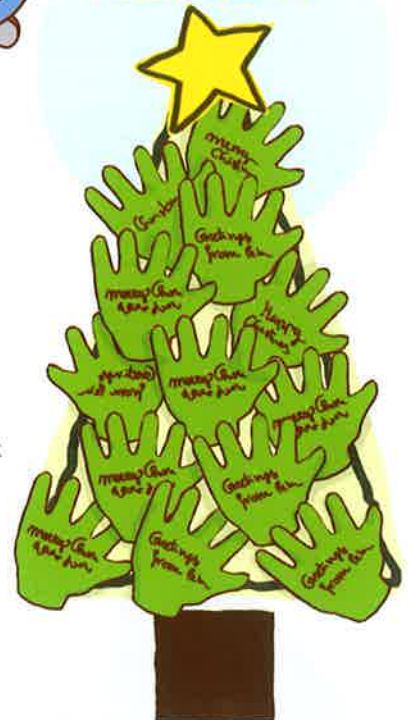


Glue the hand prints onto the tree.
