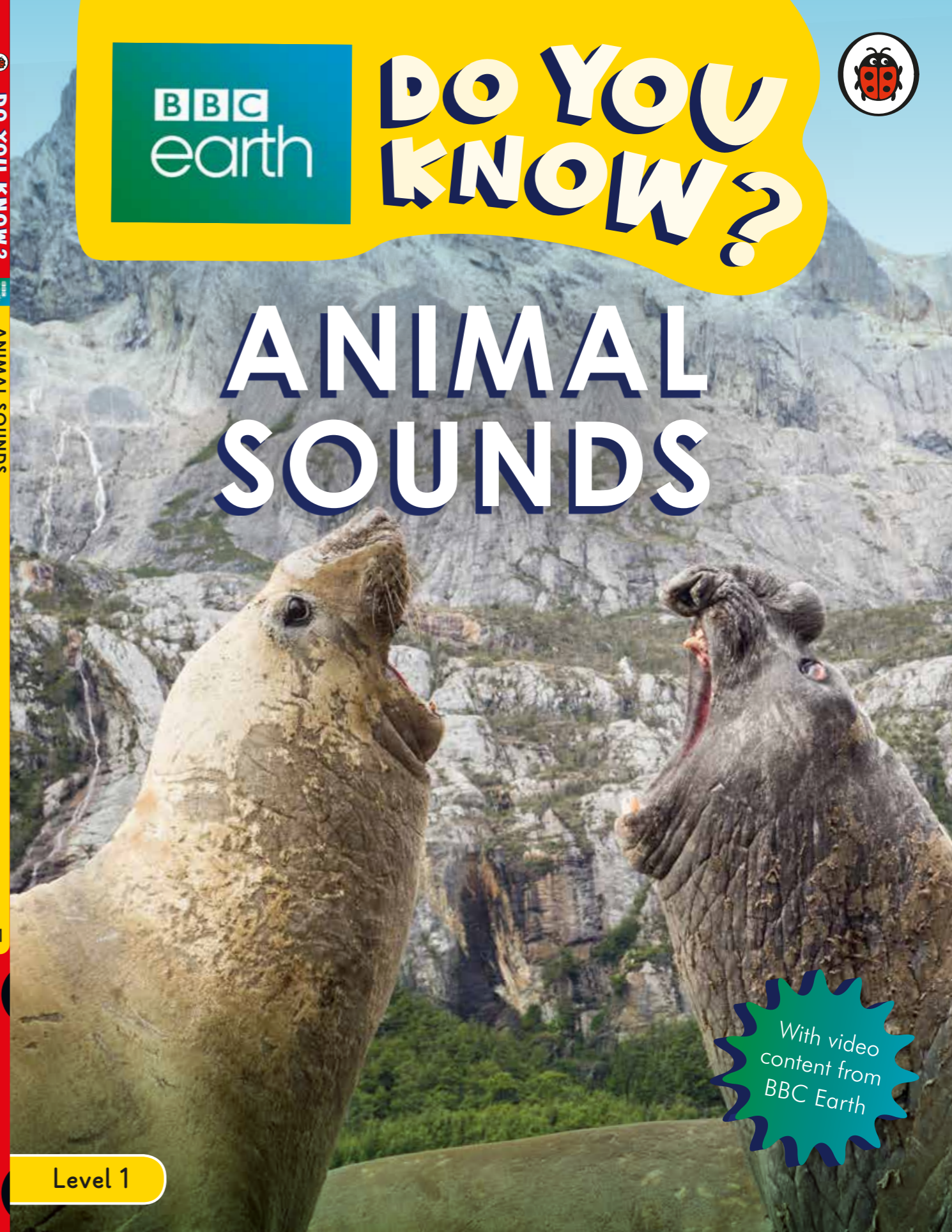

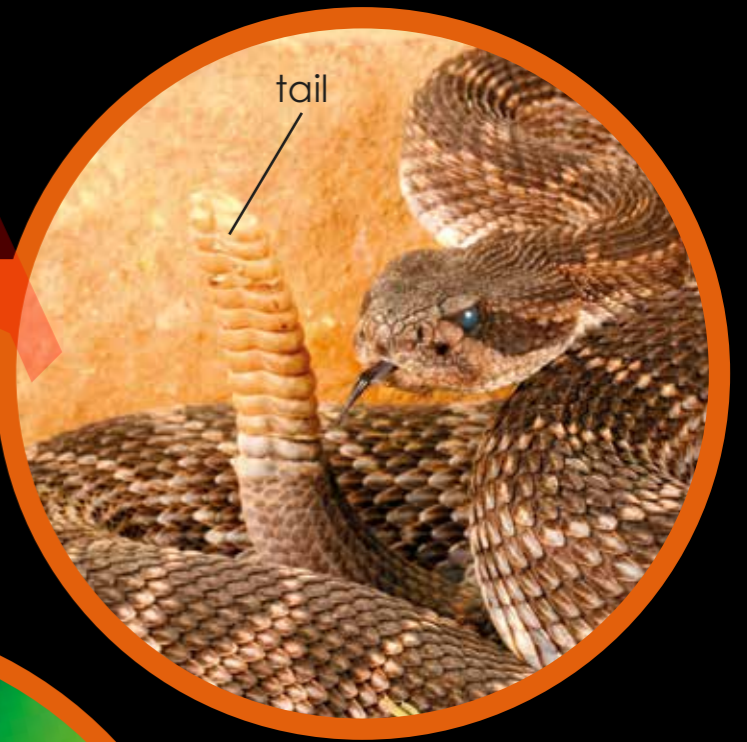


Sounds come from parts of an animal's body.
