Fairness Matters

Have you ever heard someone say something isn't fair? What does it mean to be fair?

When you make sure everyone gets a chance to play, you're showing fairness. If you play a game by the rules, you're being fair too. When you **respect** everyone, that's being fair.



Fairness is a superpower. It helps others feel **valued**. It helps them feel comfortable. When you're fair, people will trust you. It's one way you can treat people the way you want to be treated.





Sometimes people are not fair. This can make other people feel left out. It can hurt people's feelings. They might feel sad or mad.
