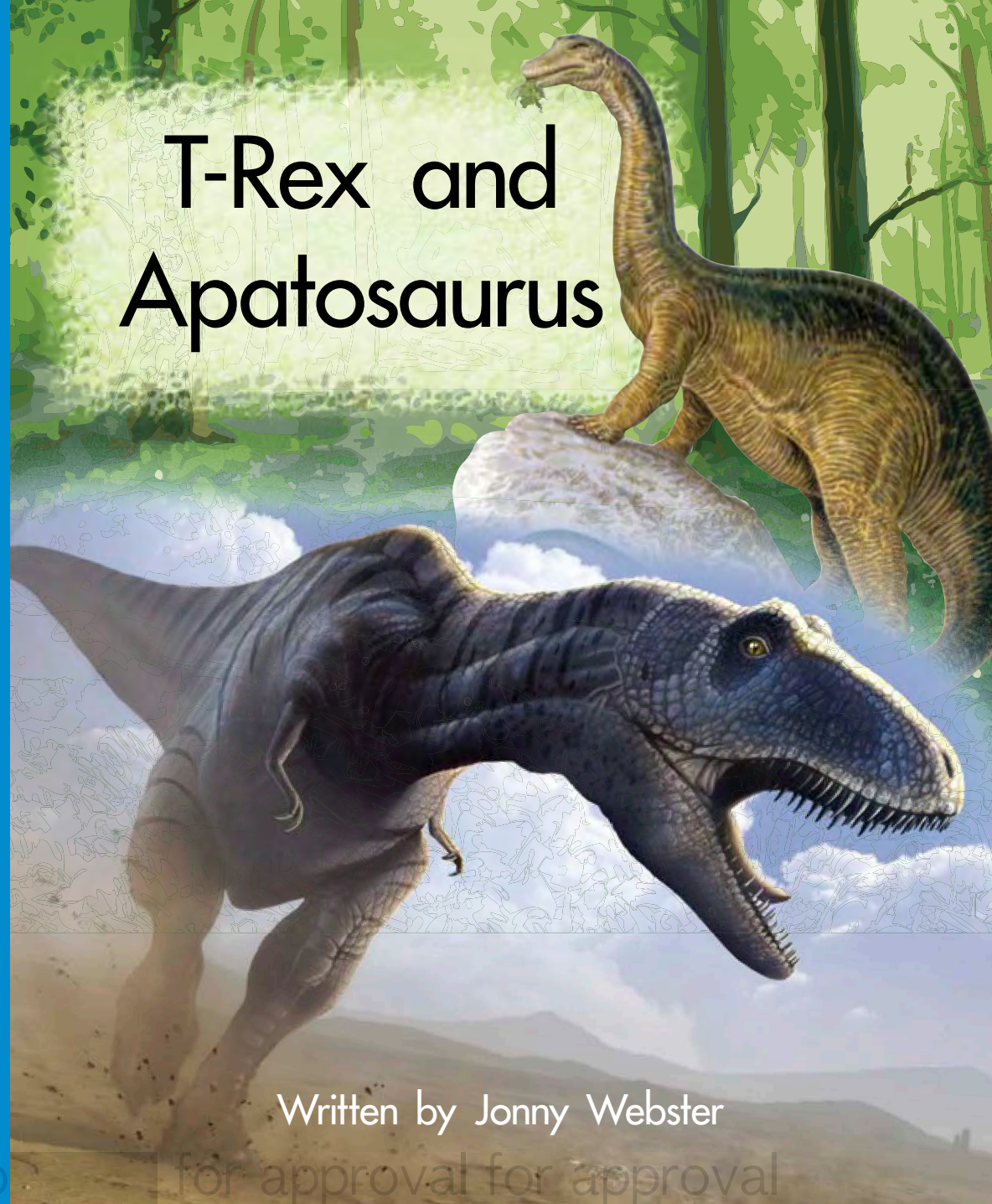

# T-Rex and Apatosaurus

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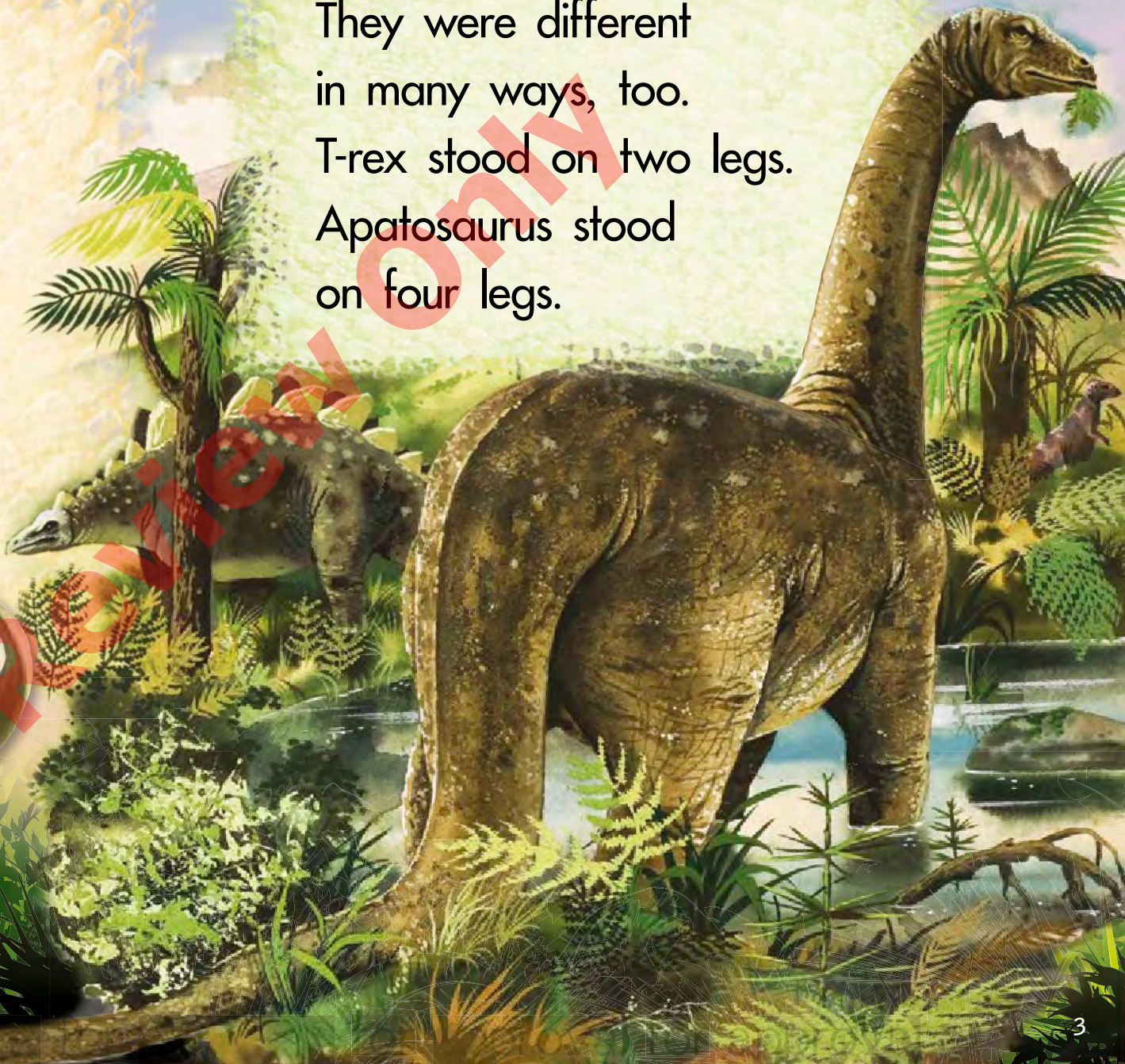
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## Two Dinosaurs

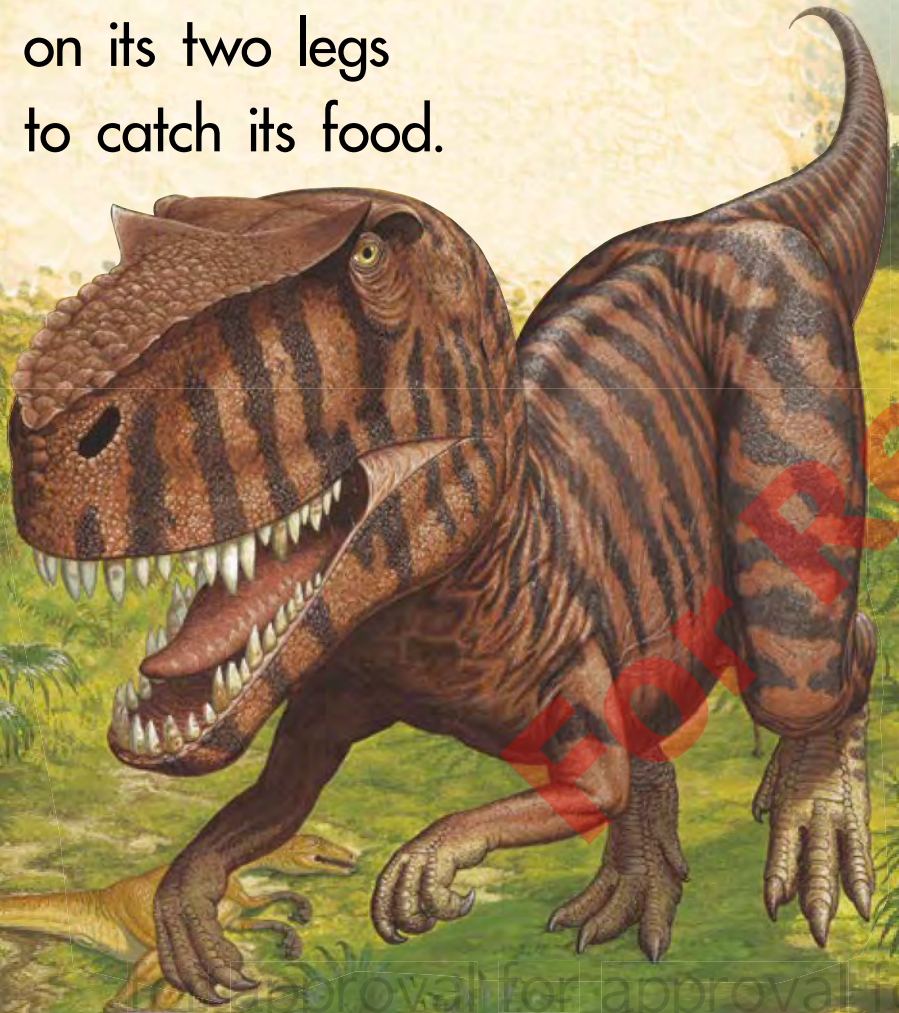
They were different in many ways, too. T-rex stood on two legs. Apatosaurus stood on four legs.
