Meredith said to Dad.

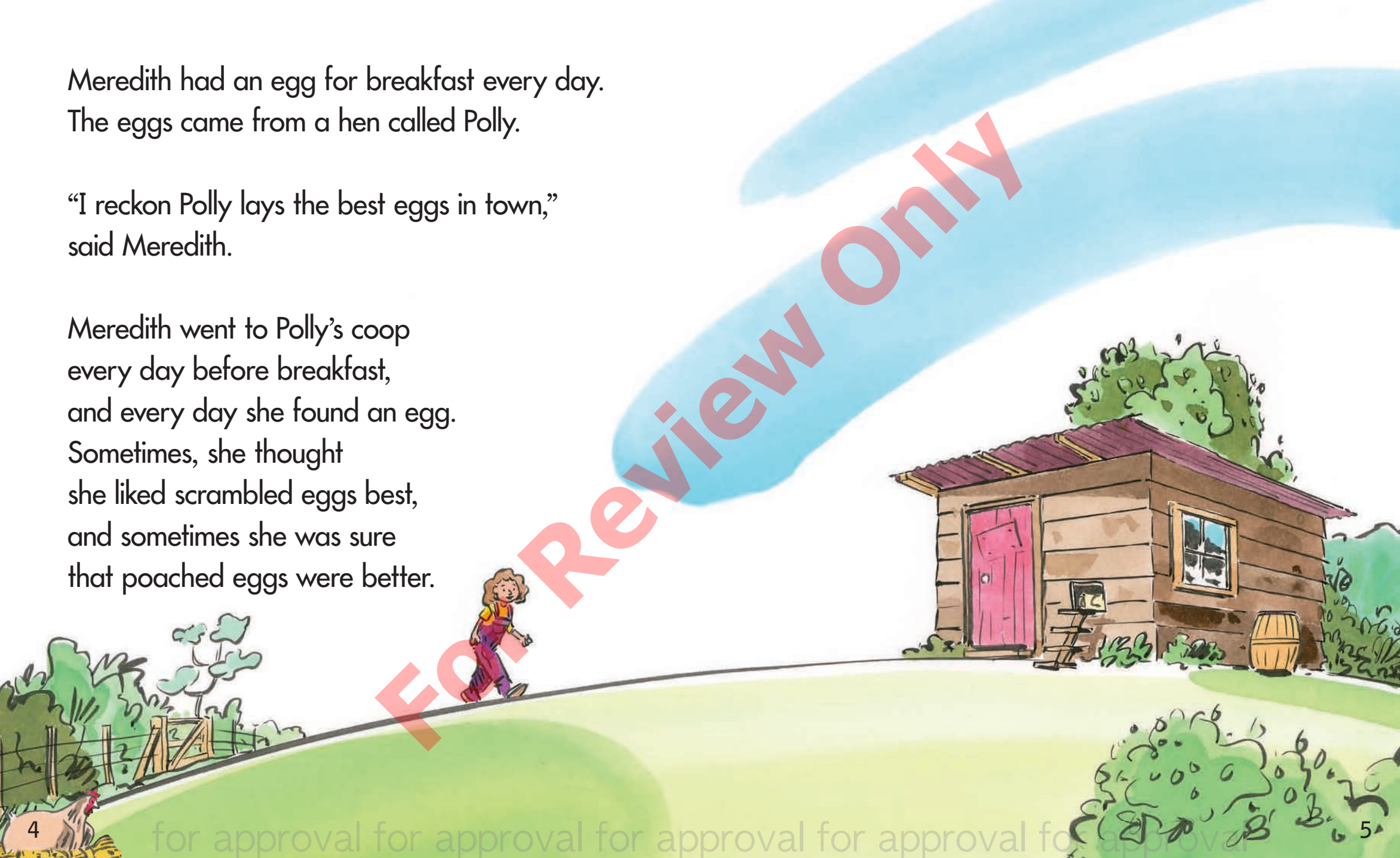
“Go and get it then,” Dad smiled.
