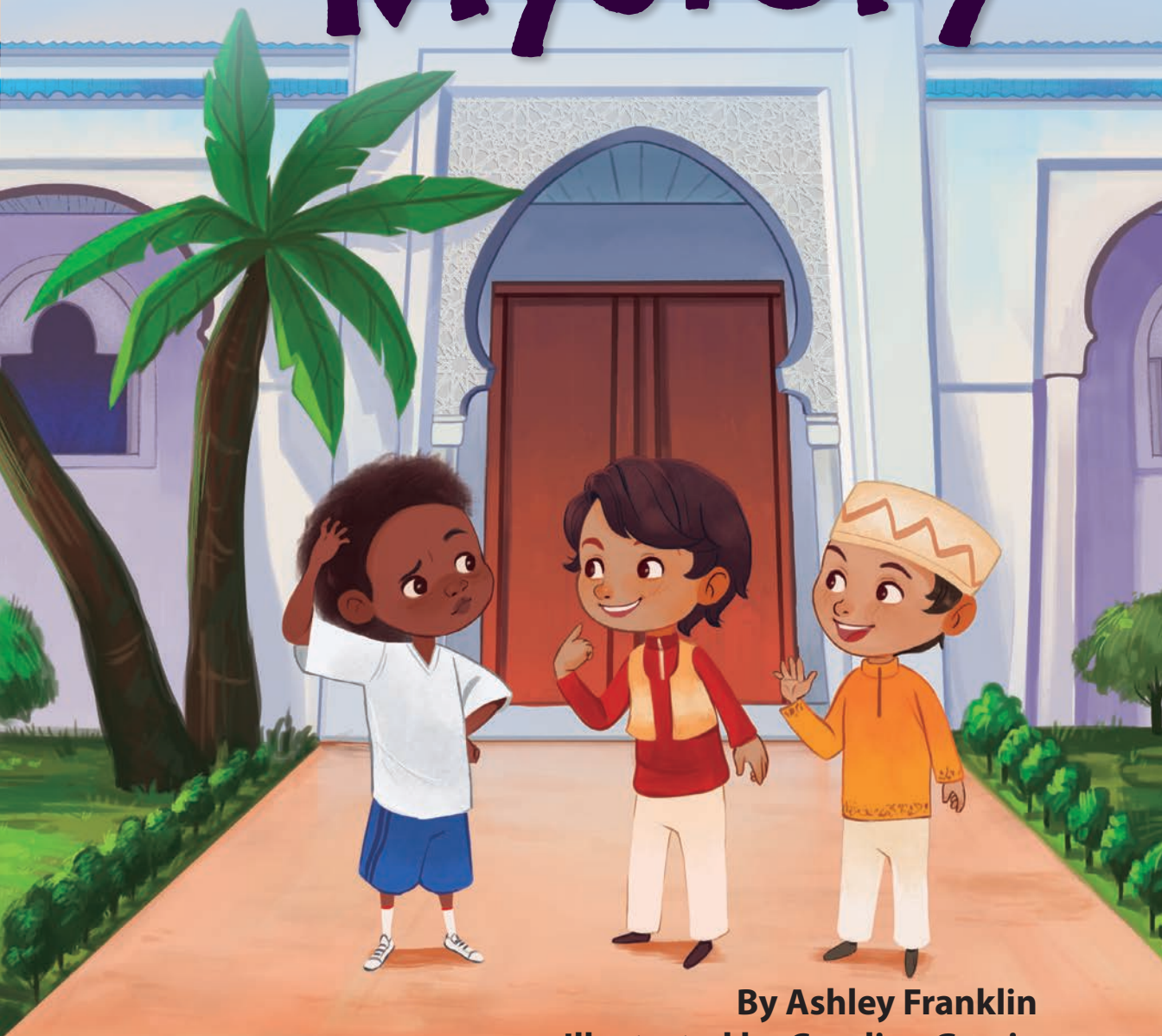

during the flight.

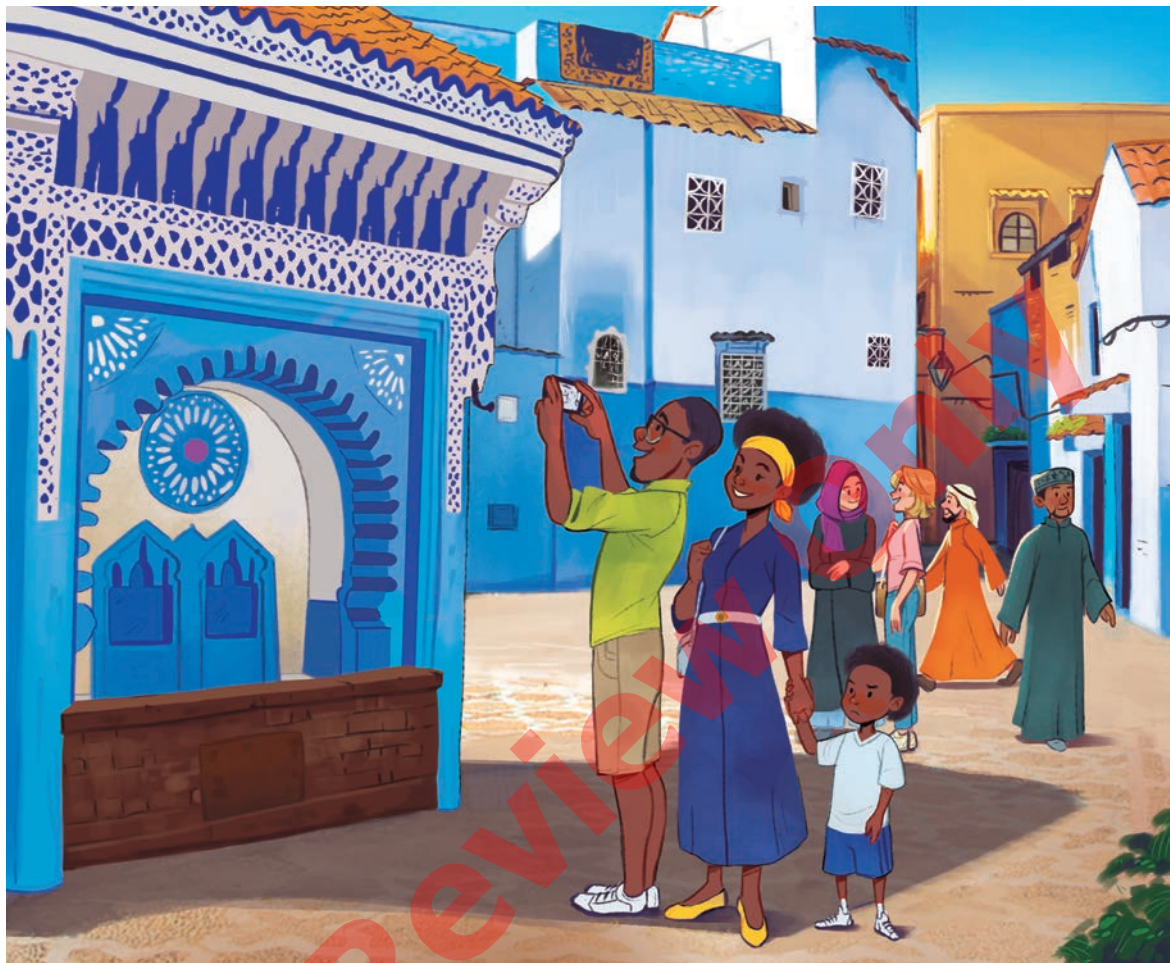
So, Michael did not hear what
