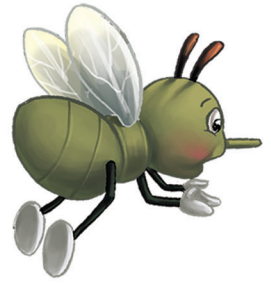


The Flies and the Honey

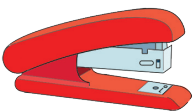
1 lolly stick — 

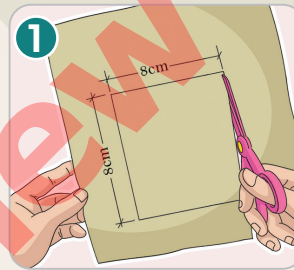
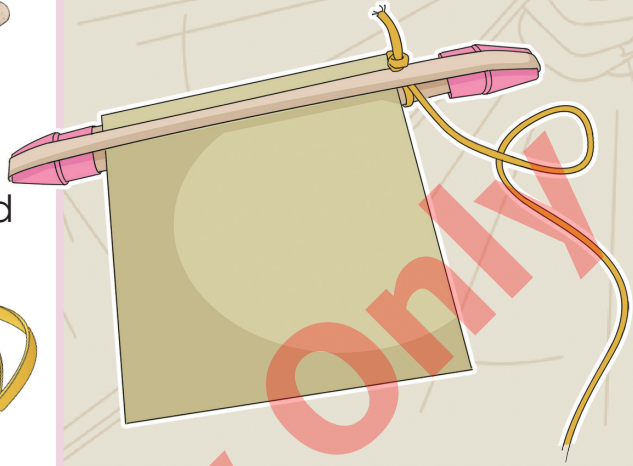
— colourful card

string — 

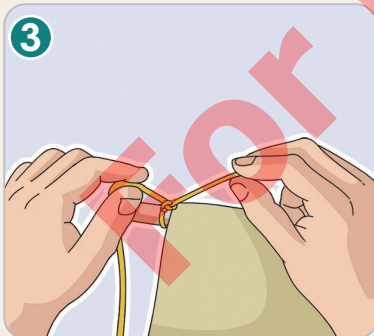
— a stapler 



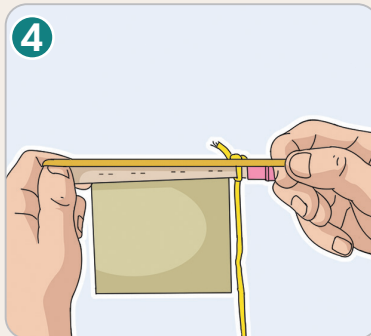
Cut a square piece of card, 8 cm by 8 cm.



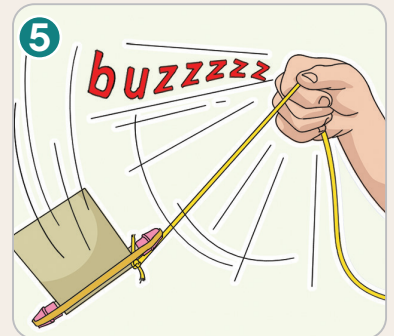
Staple the card to the middle of the lolly stick.



Tie the string around one end of the lolly stick. Then, put a pencil-top rubber on each end of the stick.



Pull the rubber band over everything.



Spin it in a circle fast, and you can hear the buzz!
