What will Erin do first?

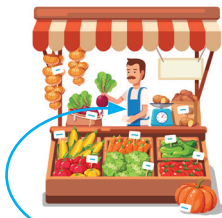

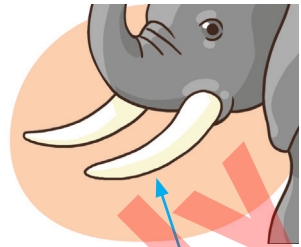
