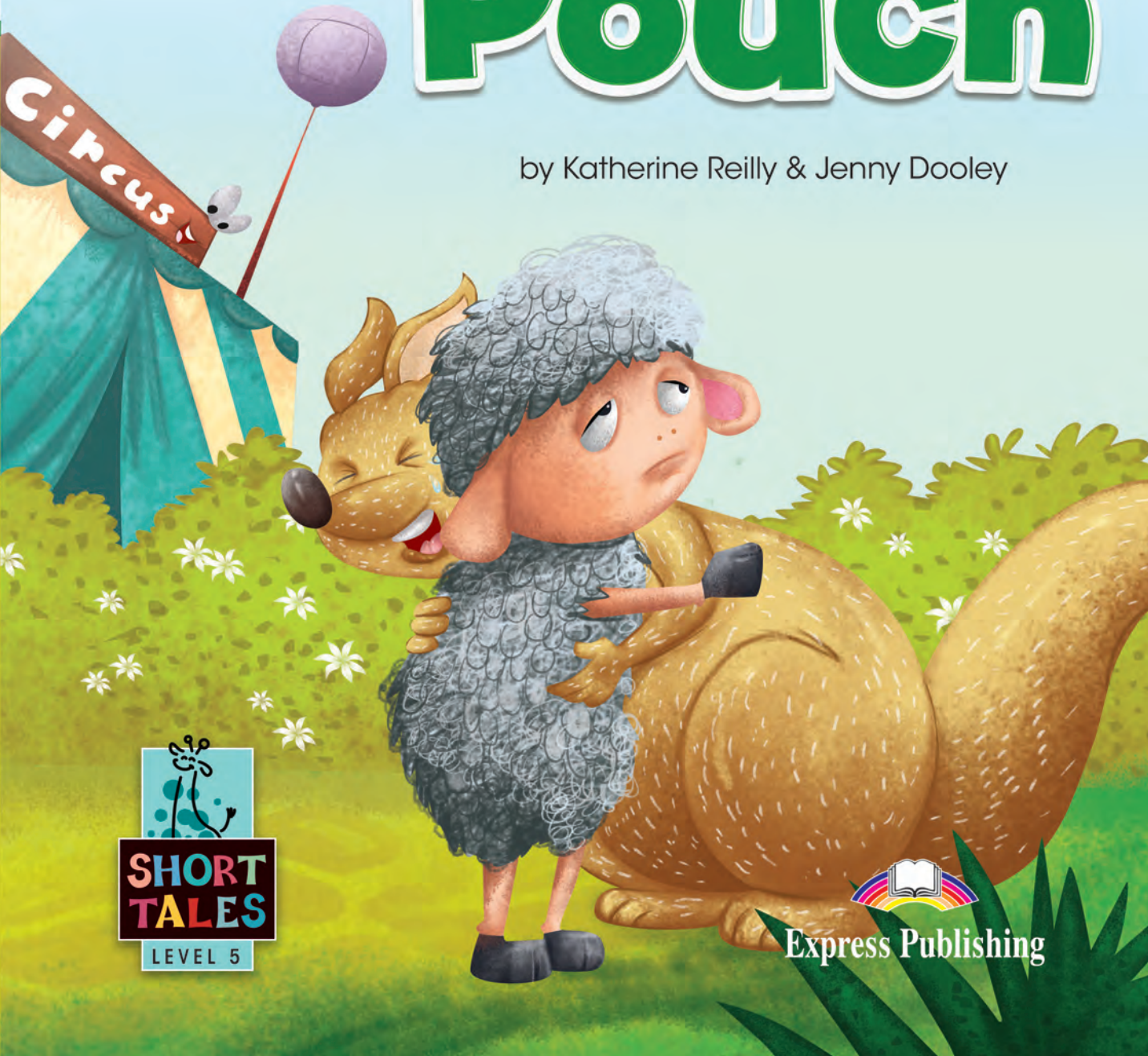


The Kangaroo That Lost Her Pouch

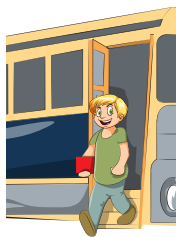
