in 1954.



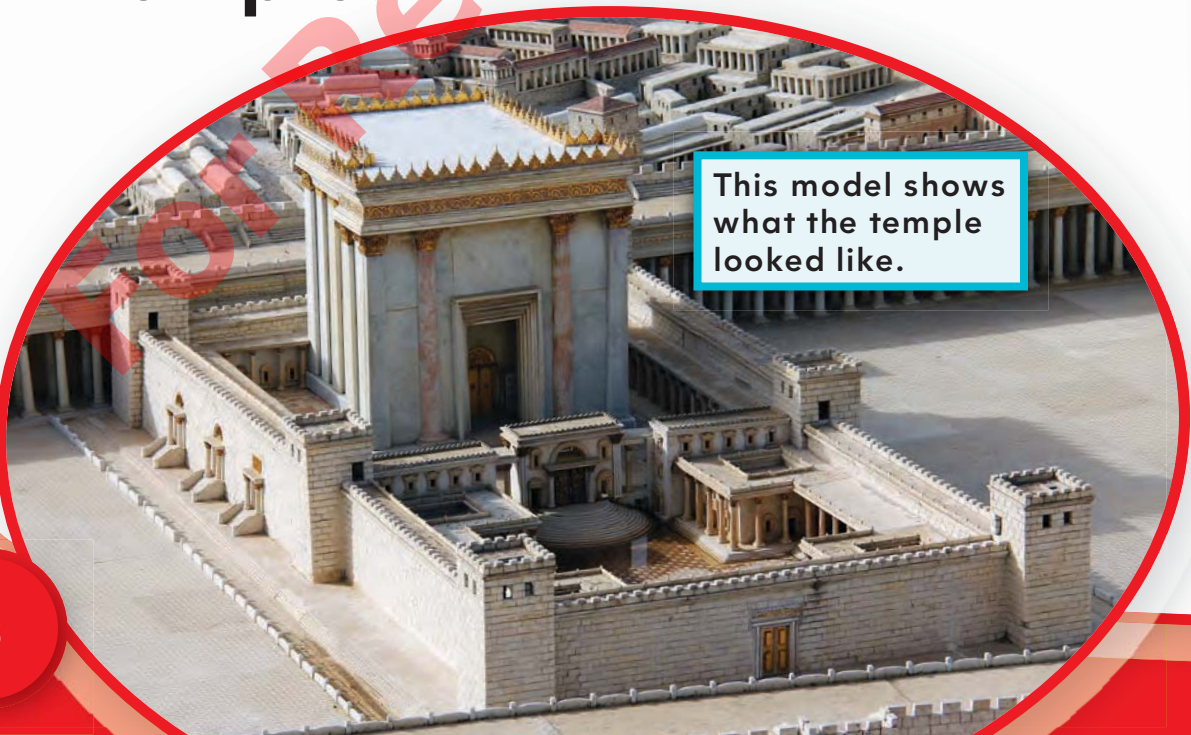
Hanukkah is a Jewish **holiday**. It is the “festival of lights.” It honors a time from the past.
