

I Want a Pound of Plums!



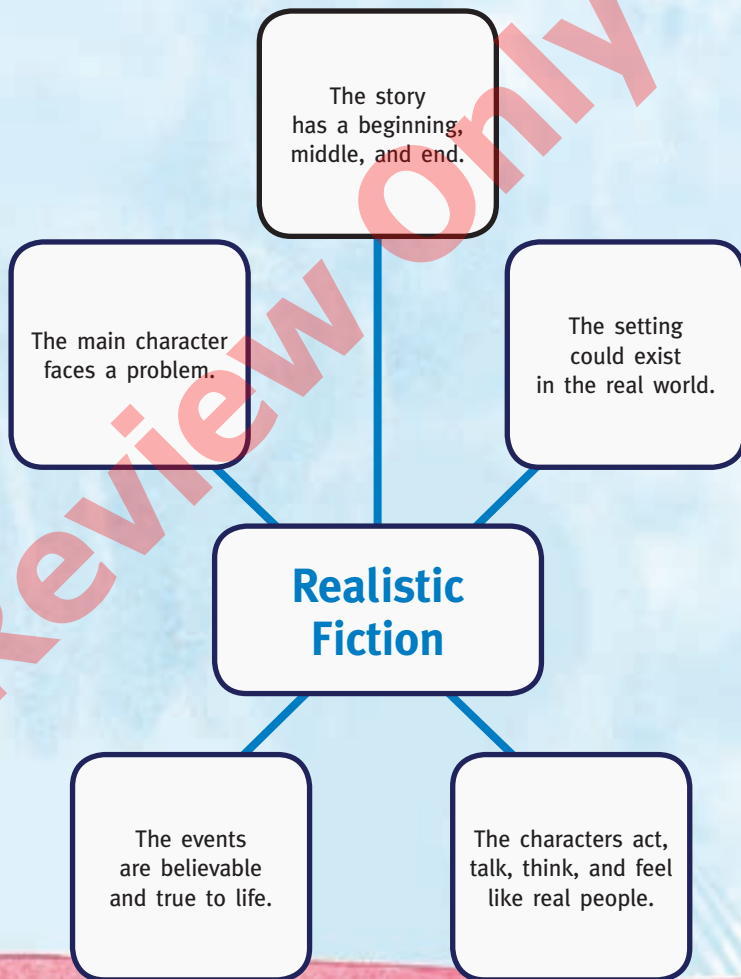
