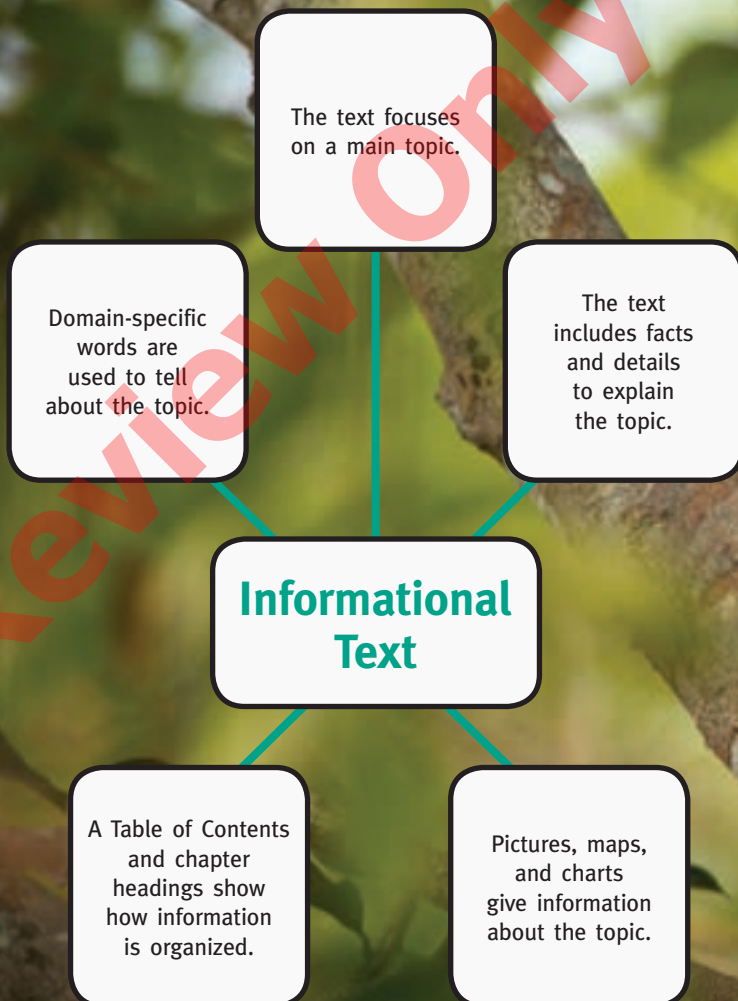

Some birds are big. The Andean condor is a very big bird. Other birds are small. The hummingbird is a very small bird.

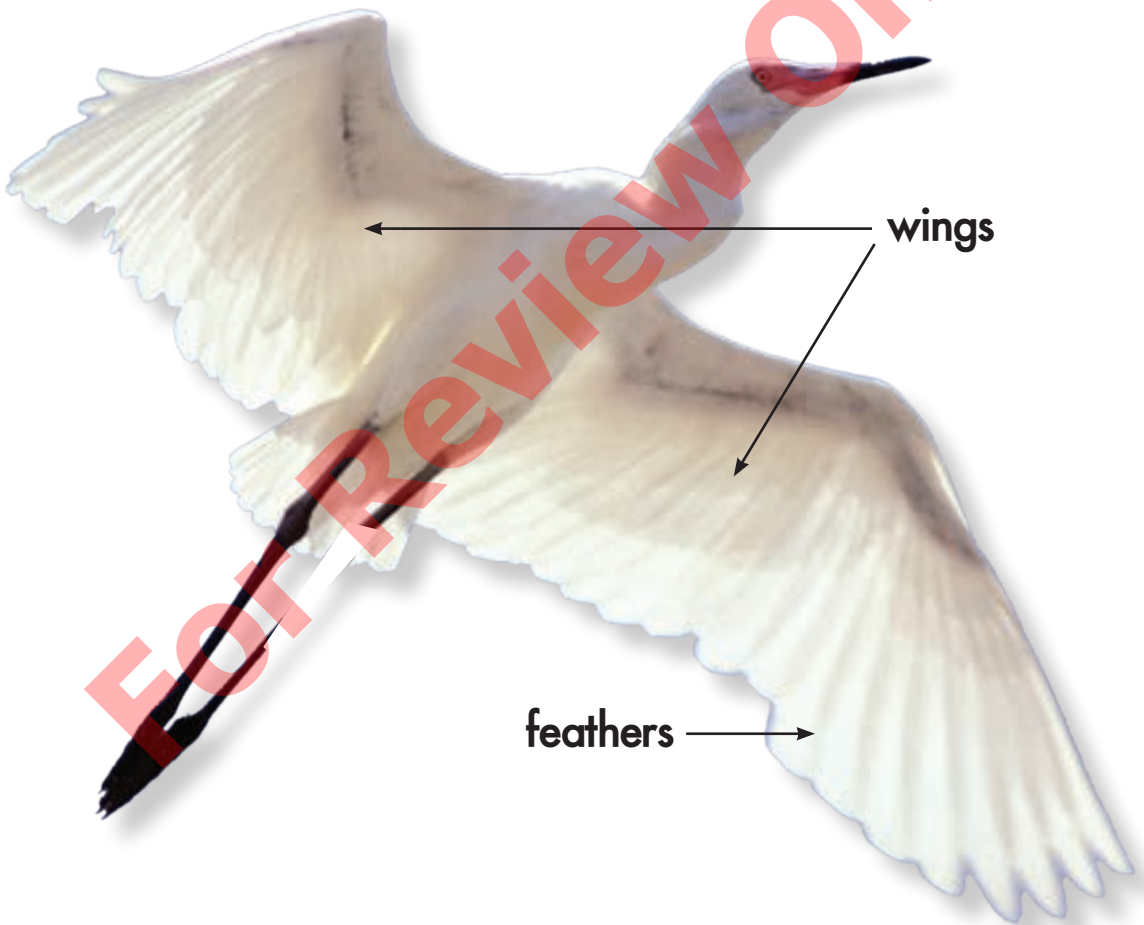
