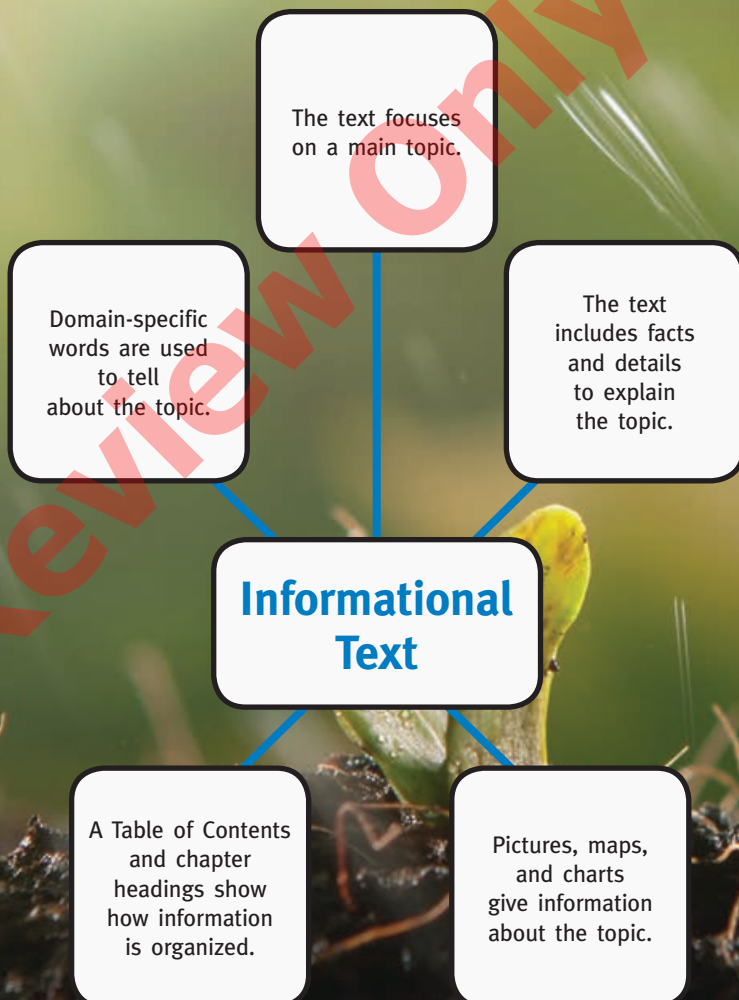


Plants

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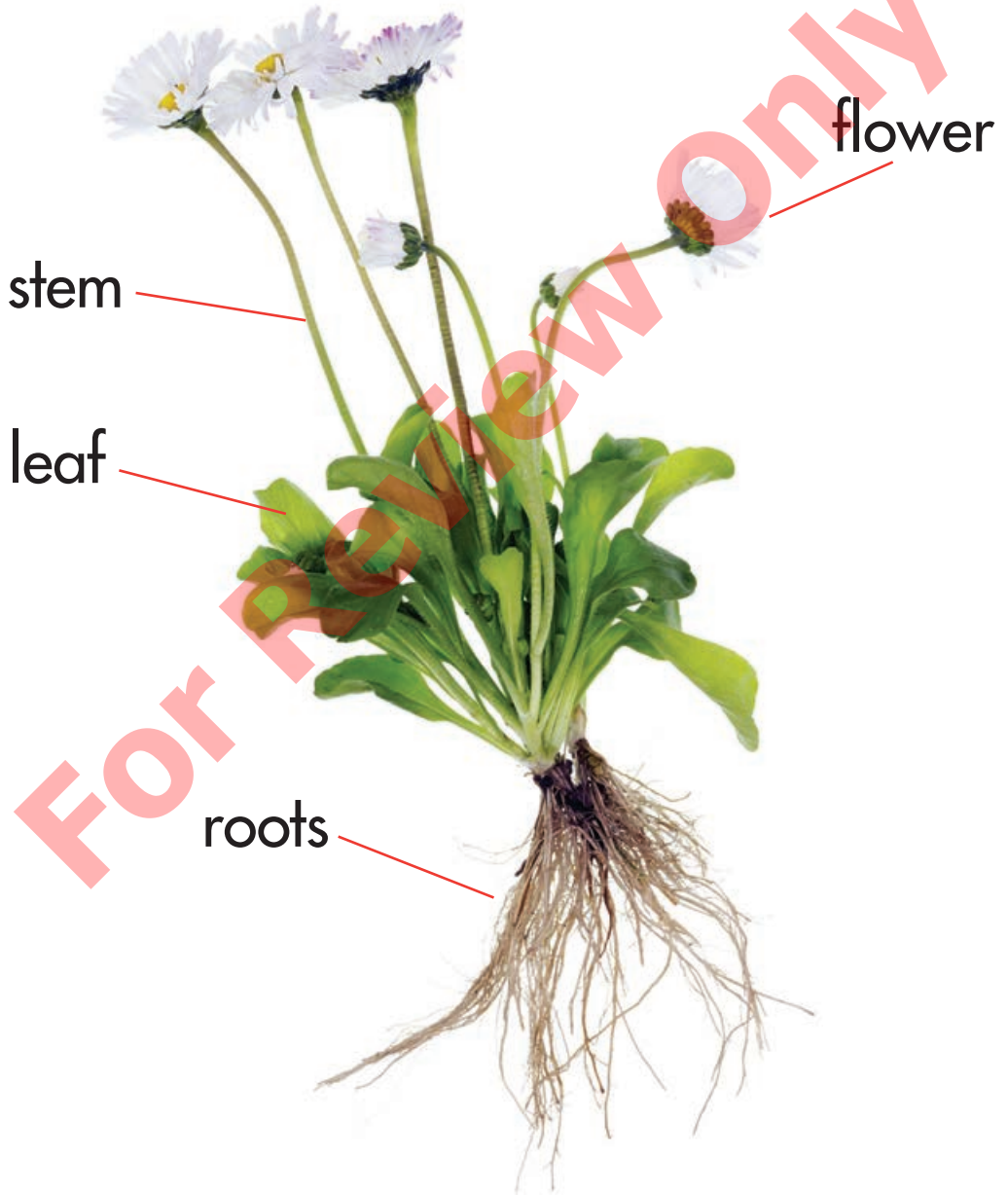
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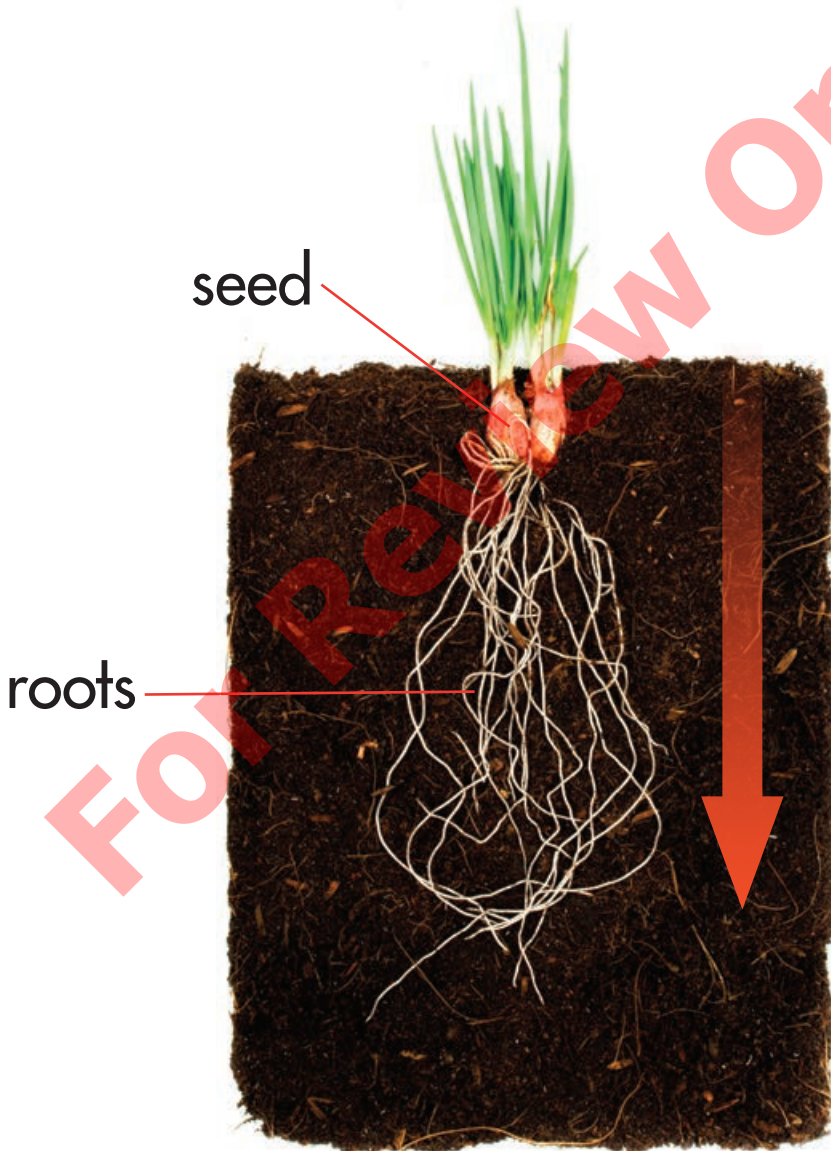
This is a plant. A plant has many parts.



Most plants start with a seed.
The seed grows in the ground.



The first things to grow from the seed are the roots. The roots grow downward into the ground.



The roots keep the plant
in the earth.



Next, after the roots, comes the stem. The stem grows upward and supports the plant.

Some plants have only one stem.
Other plants have many stems.



From the stems, the leaves of the plant grow.



Most leaves are green.
Some leaves can be purple!
