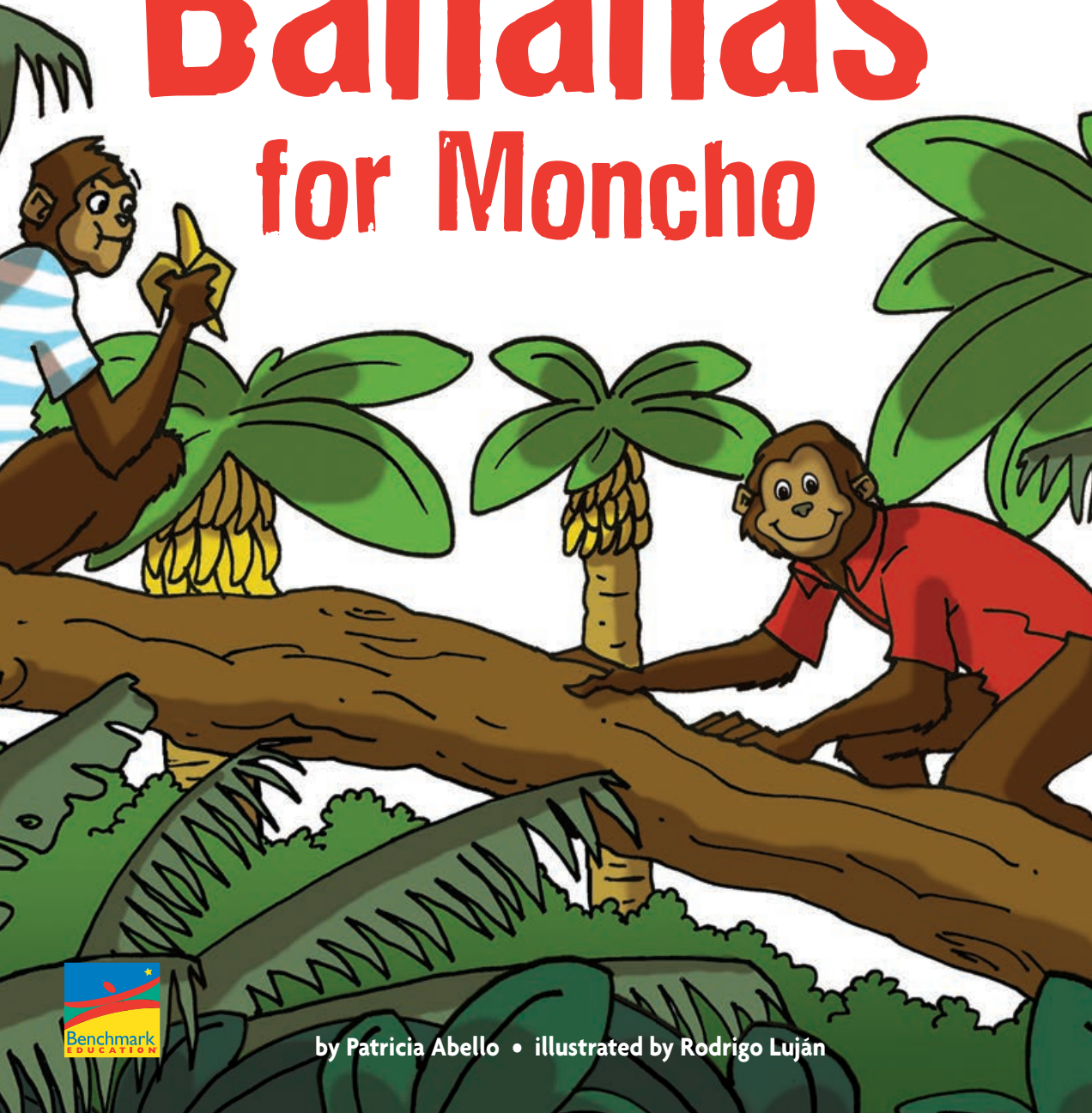


No More Bananas for Moncho

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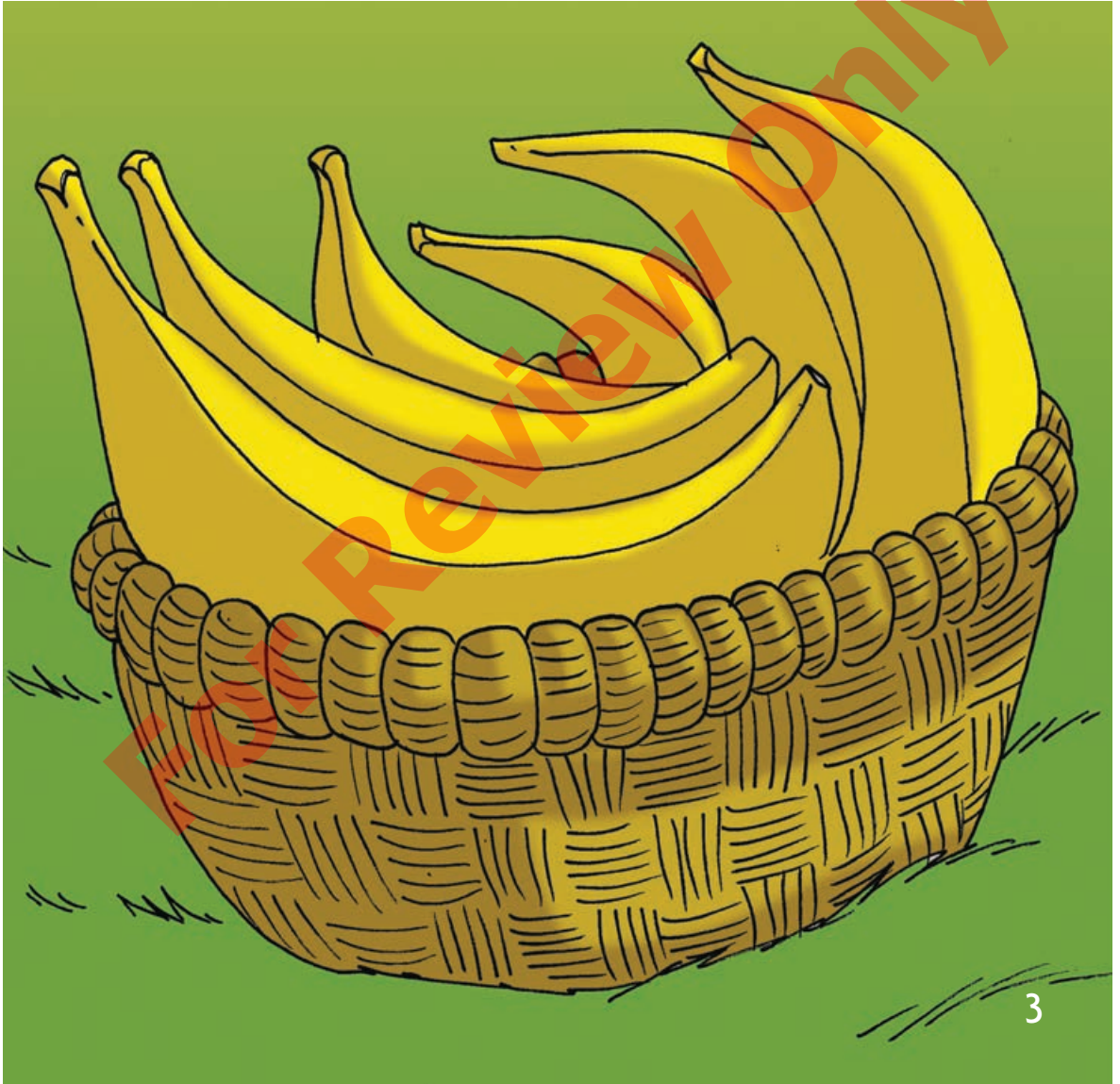
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There is an island where only monkeys live.
