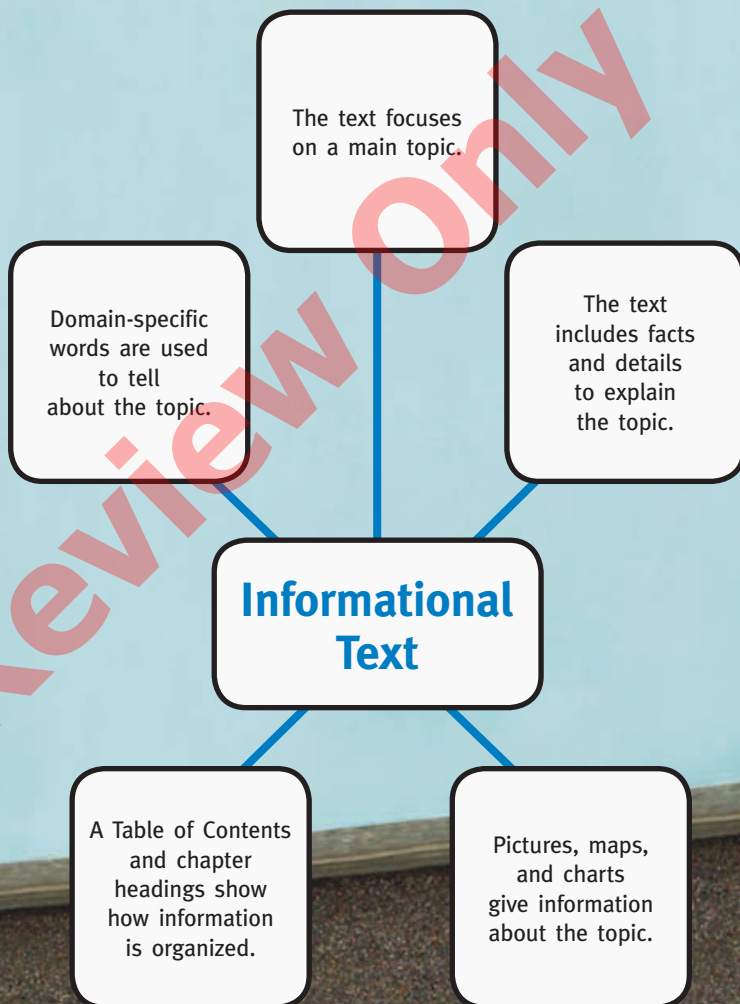


How Much Does It Weigh?

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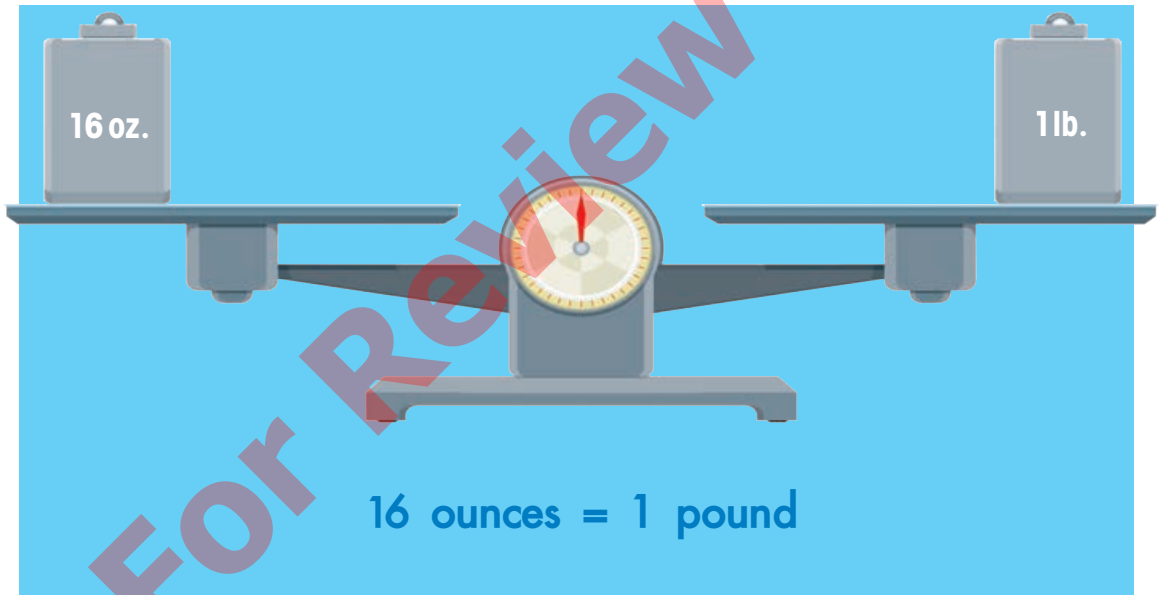
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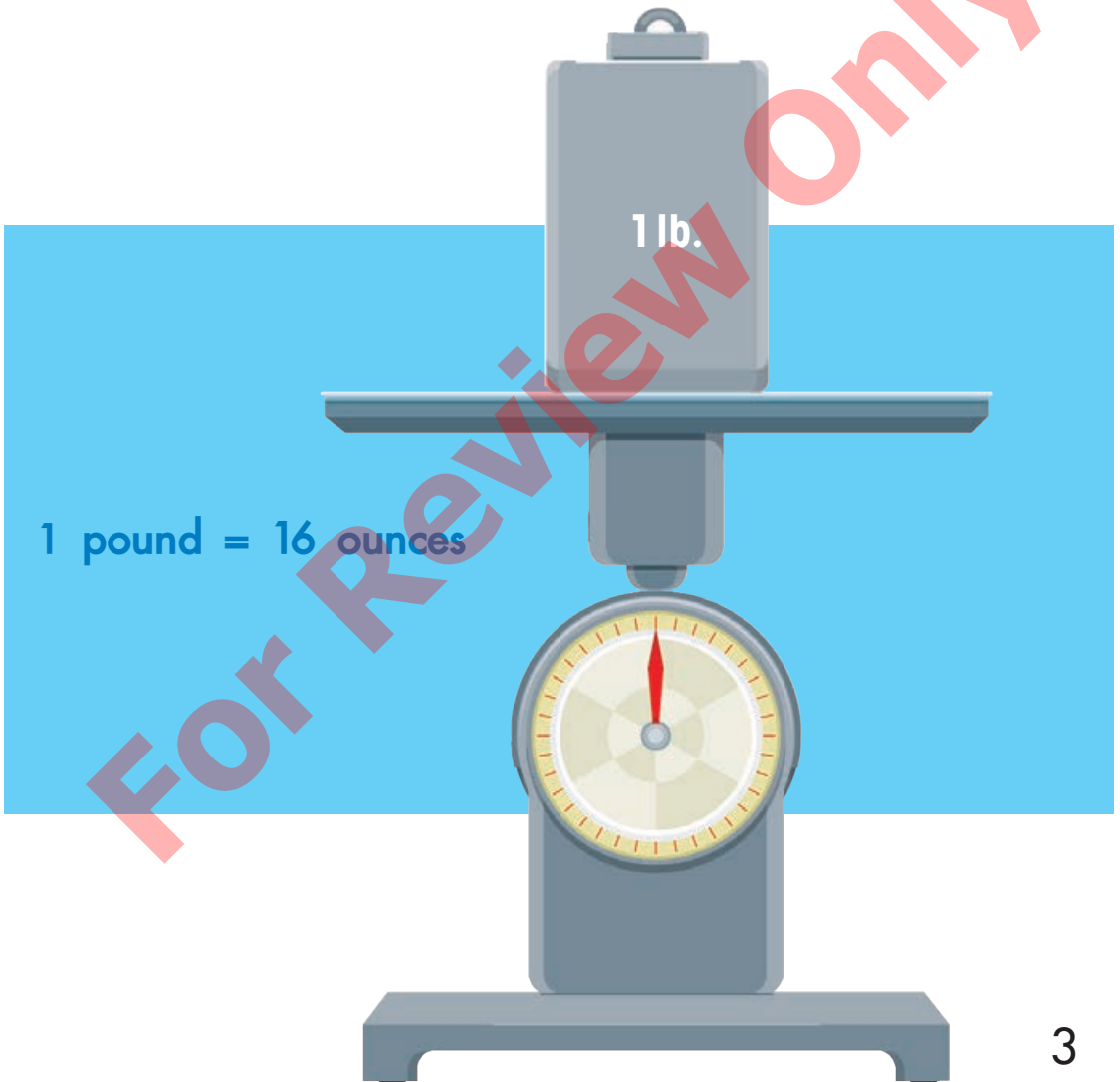
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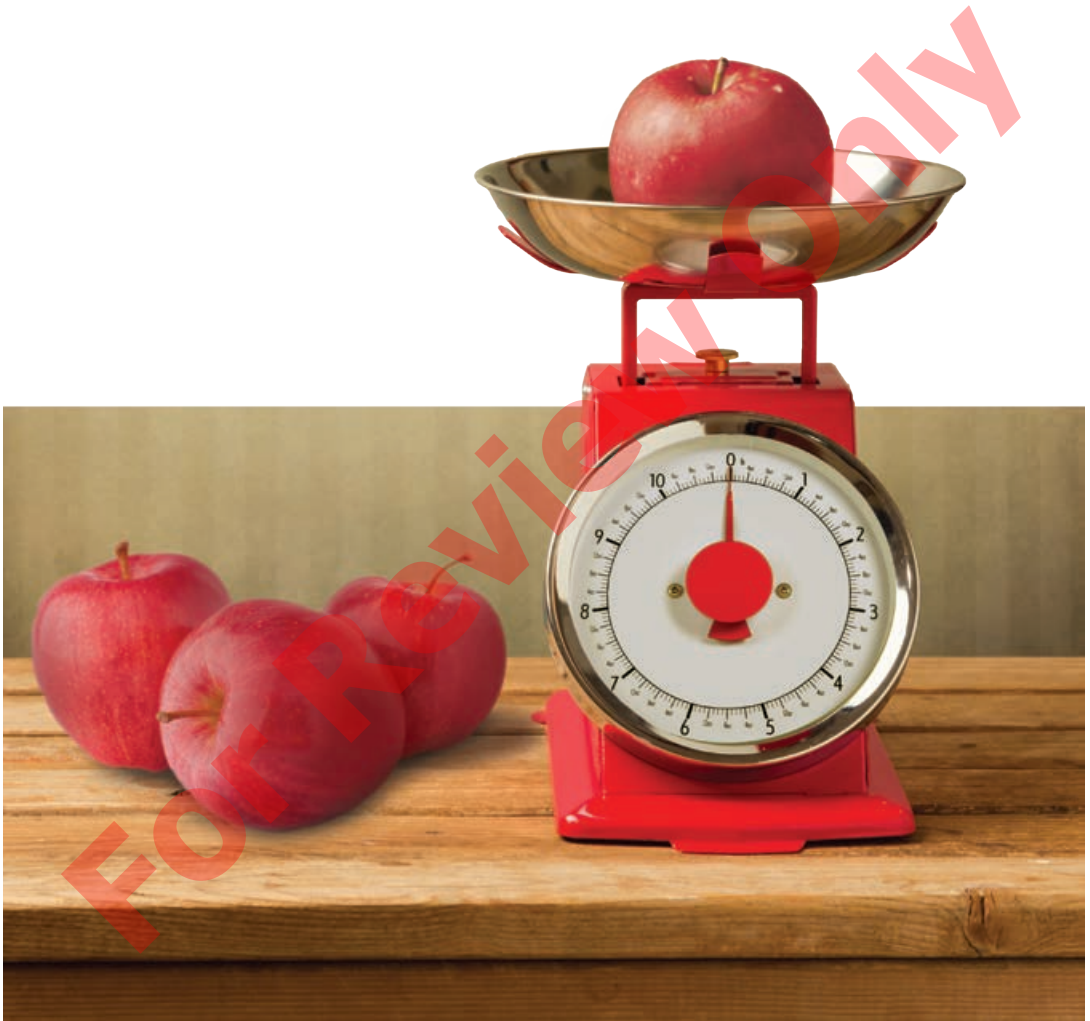
You can measure weight in pounds and ounces. Pound can be written as “lb.”



There are 16 ounces
in 1 pound. Ounce
can be written as “oz.”



Ounces are used to weigh things that are light.



A one-dollar bill weighs about $\frac{1}{4}$ of an ounce. A thousand dollar bills weigh a little more than two and a half pounds.



Many recipes give measurements in ounces.



▲ This recipe tells how many ounces of cheese are needed.

To make lasagna you need to know how many ounces of cheese to use.



We use pounds to weigh things that are big and heavy.



Trucks are weighed in pounds.
