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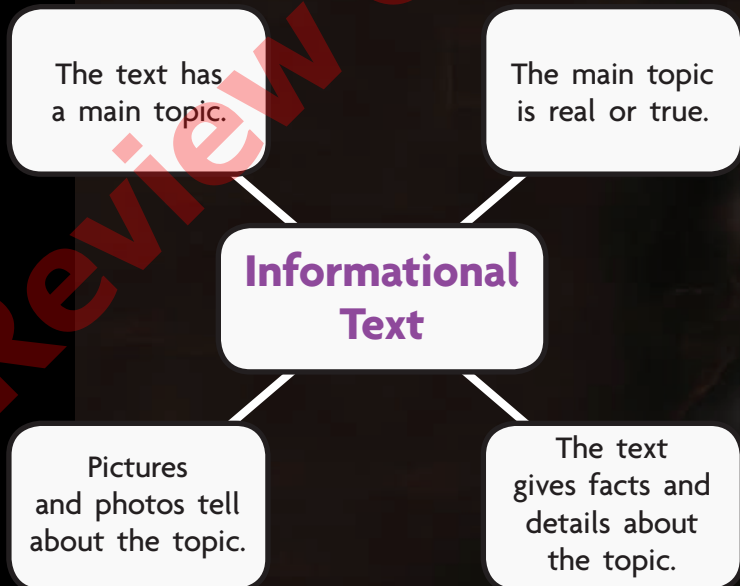
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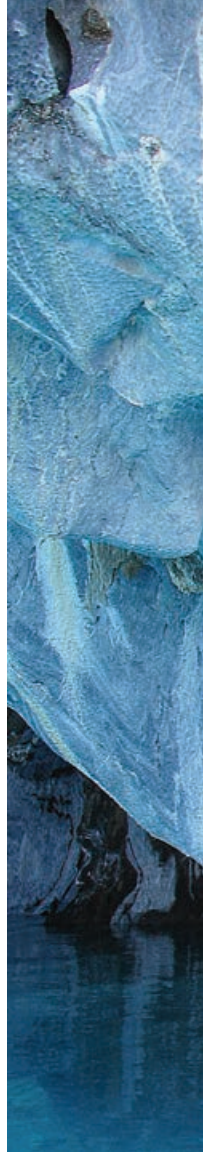
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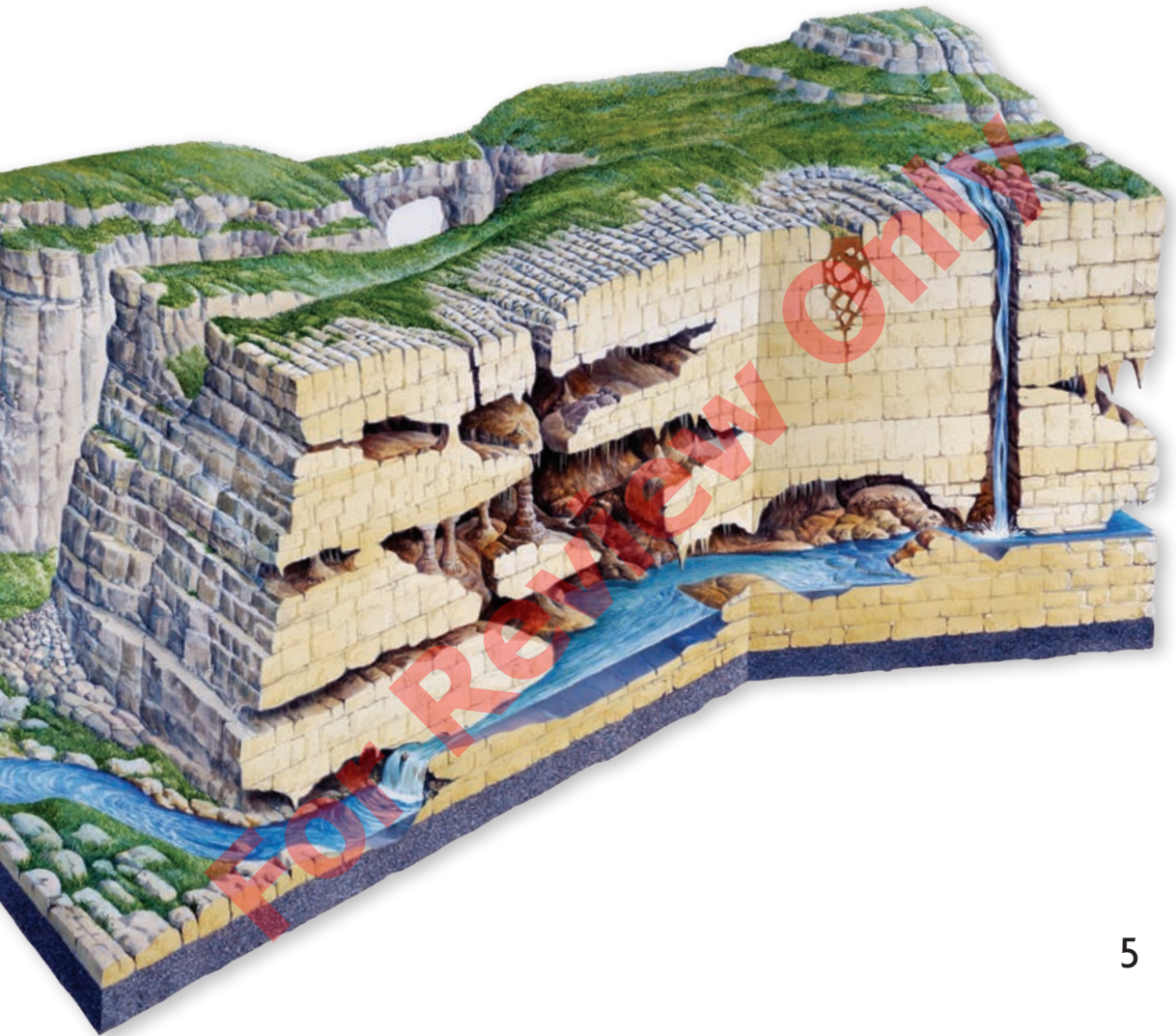
Caves are natural openings

There are ice caves.





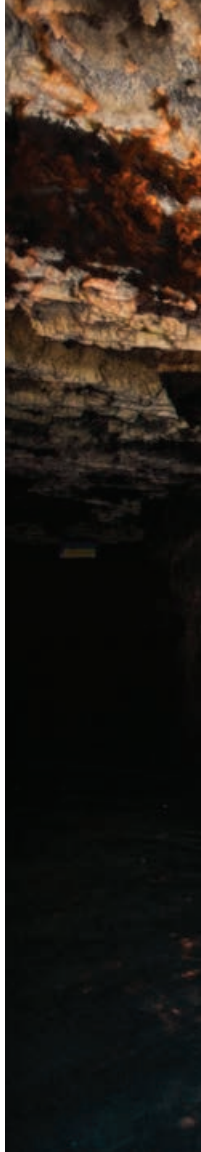
Some caves are below the sea.
