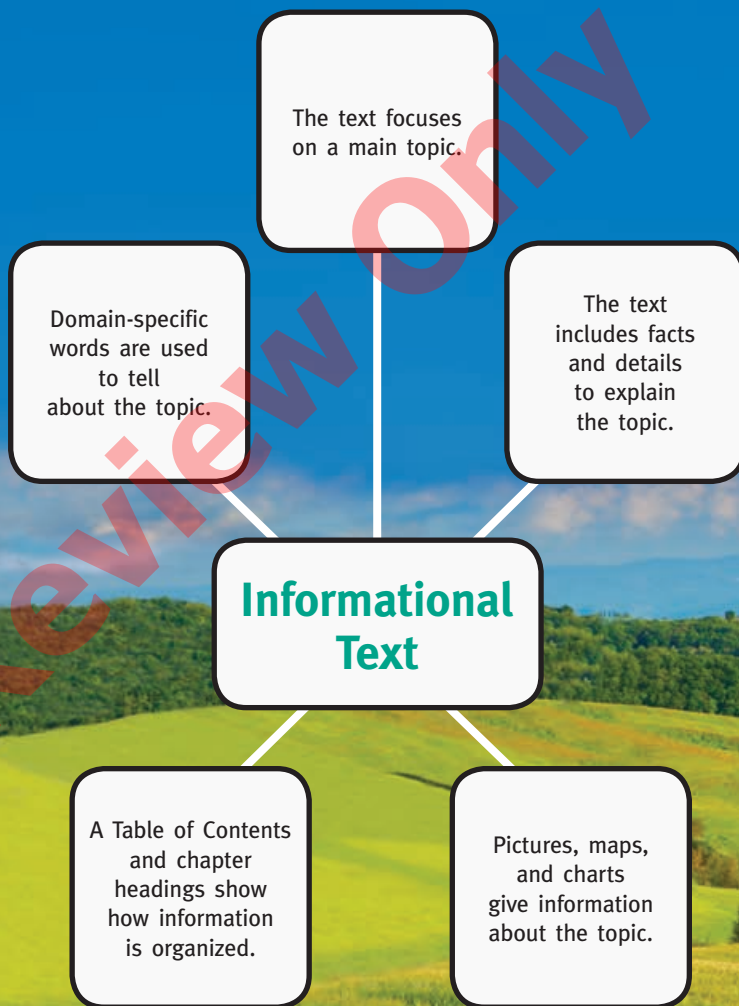

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What Is Natural Light?

Sunlight is called natural light. Natural light is light that comes from something in nature, like the sun.



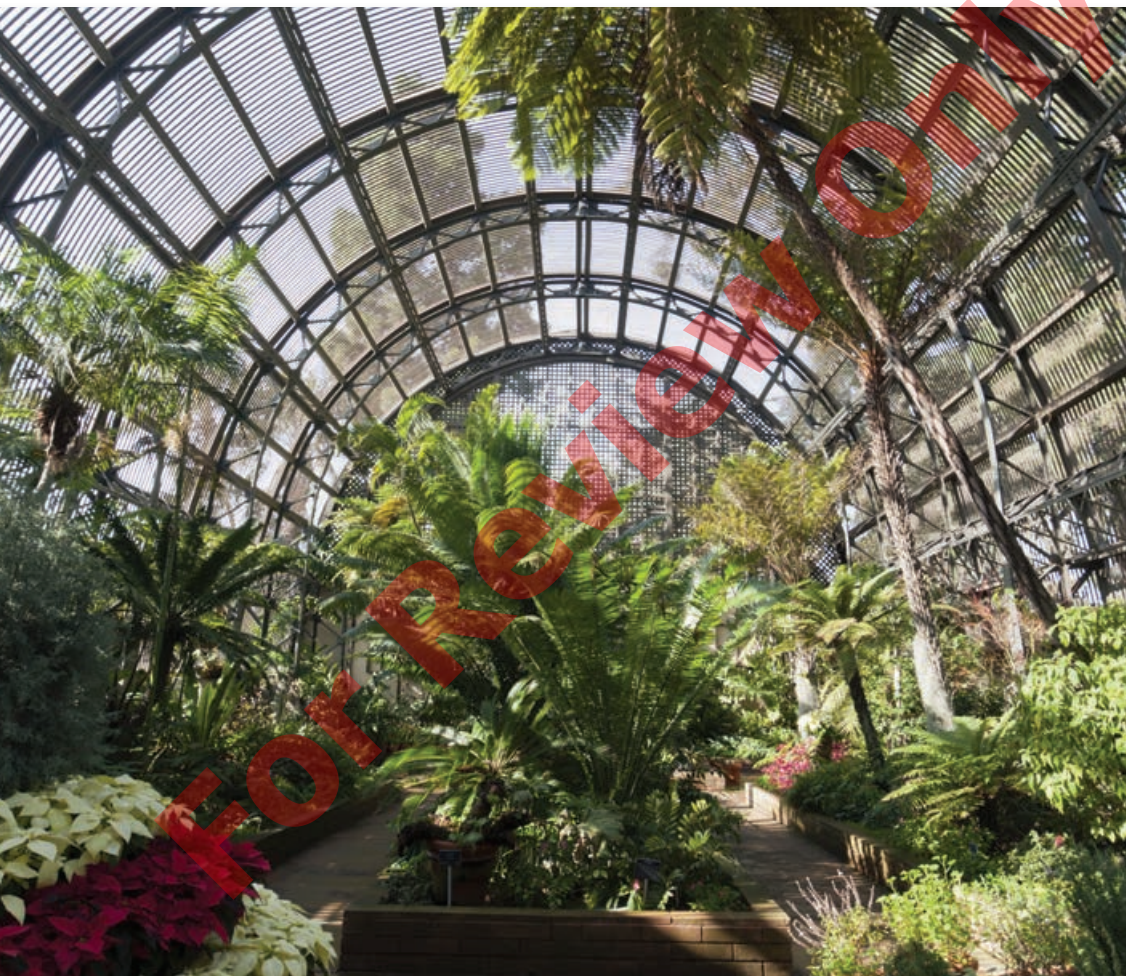
▲ These children play in natural light.

Sometimes it rains and the sun comes out. Sunlight helps you see colors.

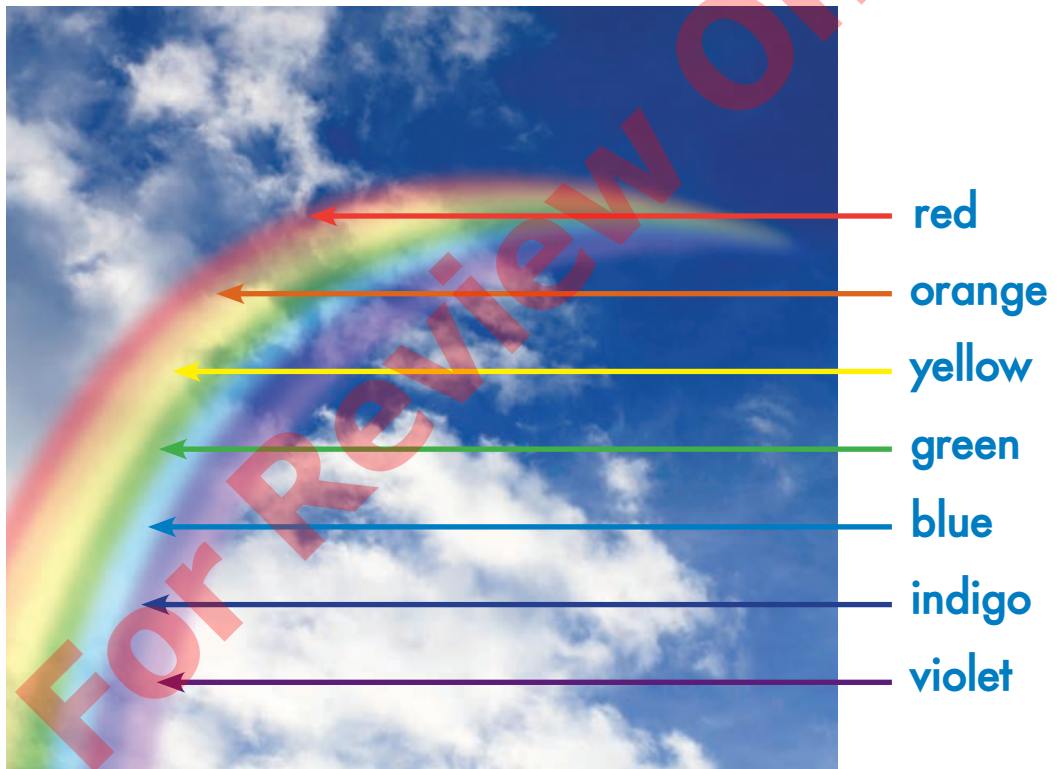


You can see a rainbow in the sky!
A rainbow is an arc of colors.



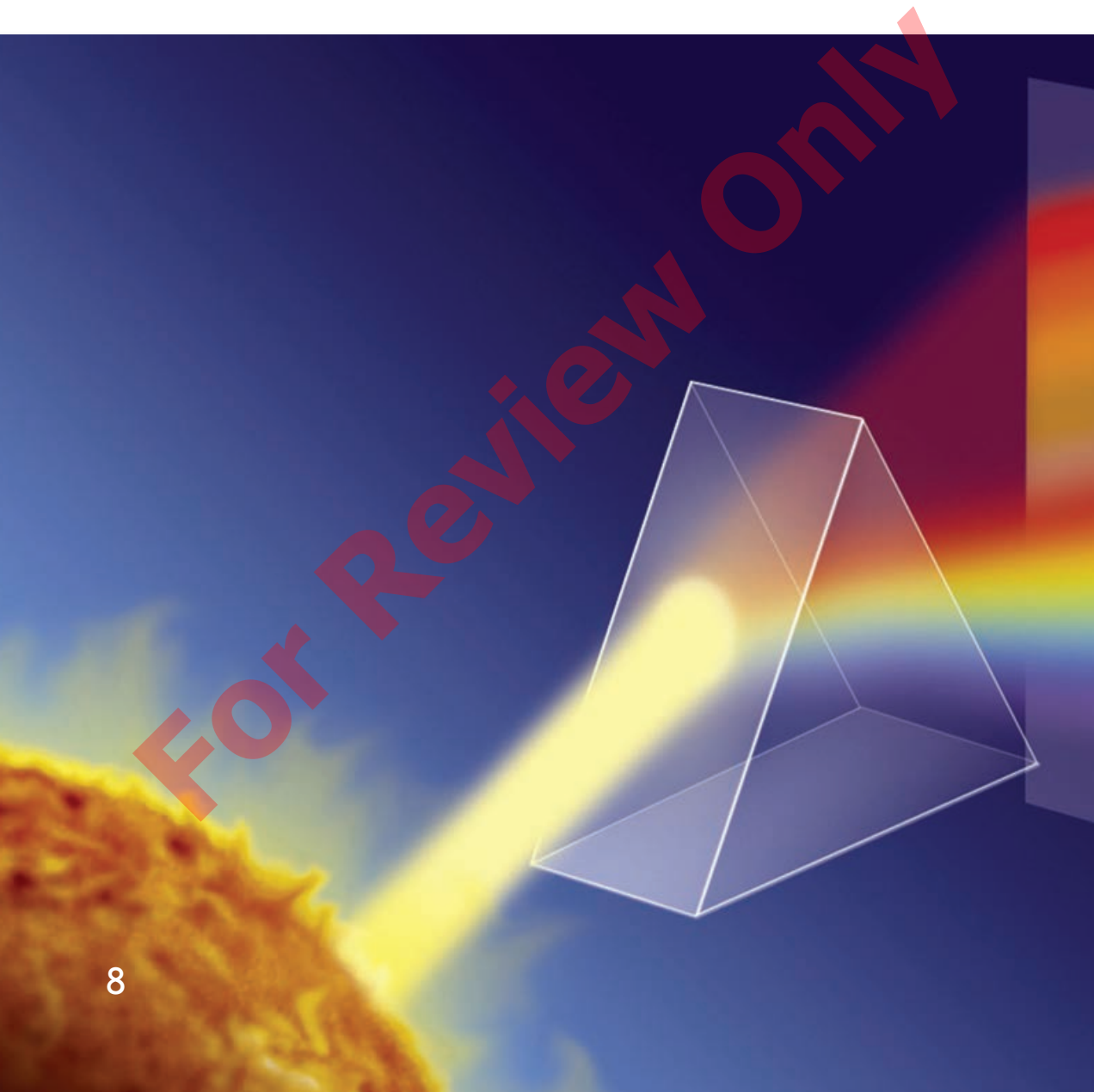
▲ This is a rainbow.
