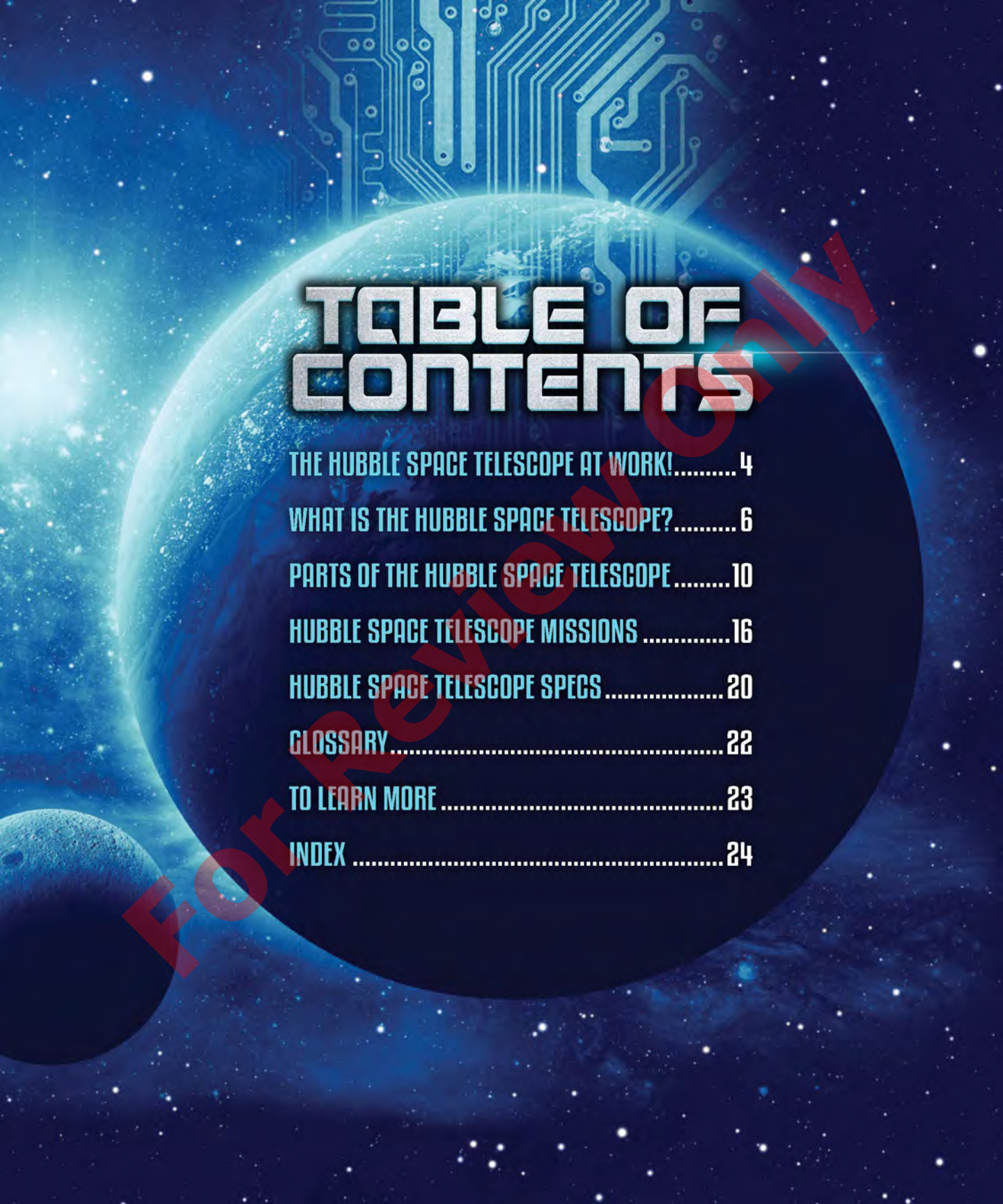


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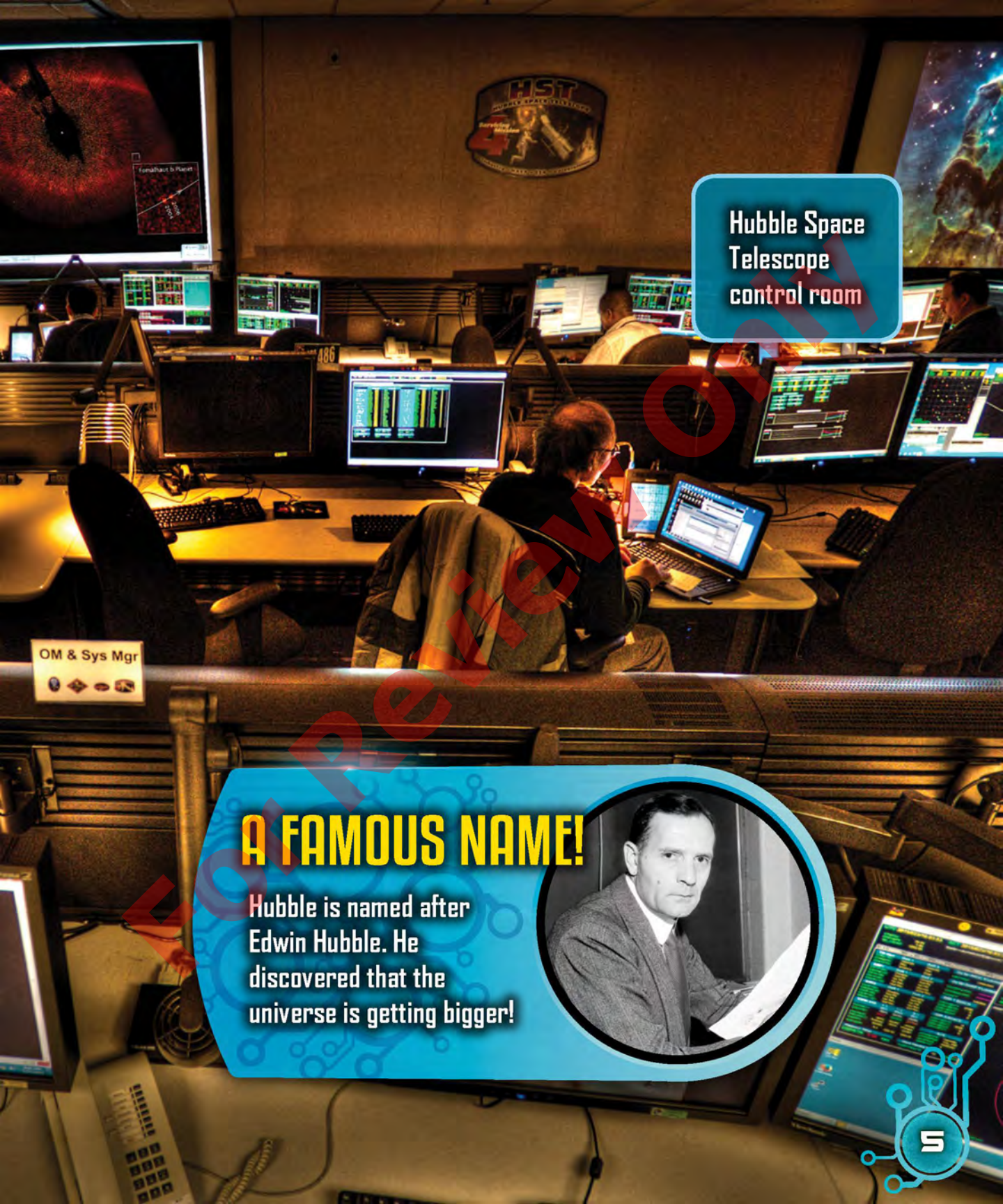
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THE HUBBLE SPACE TELESCOPE AT WORK!

WHAT IS THE HUBBLE SPACE TELESCOPE?

Hubble is one of the largest telescopes ever to be sent to space. On Earth, objects seen through a telescope might look blurry. Gases around Earth get in the way. Up in space, Hubble gets a much clearer view.



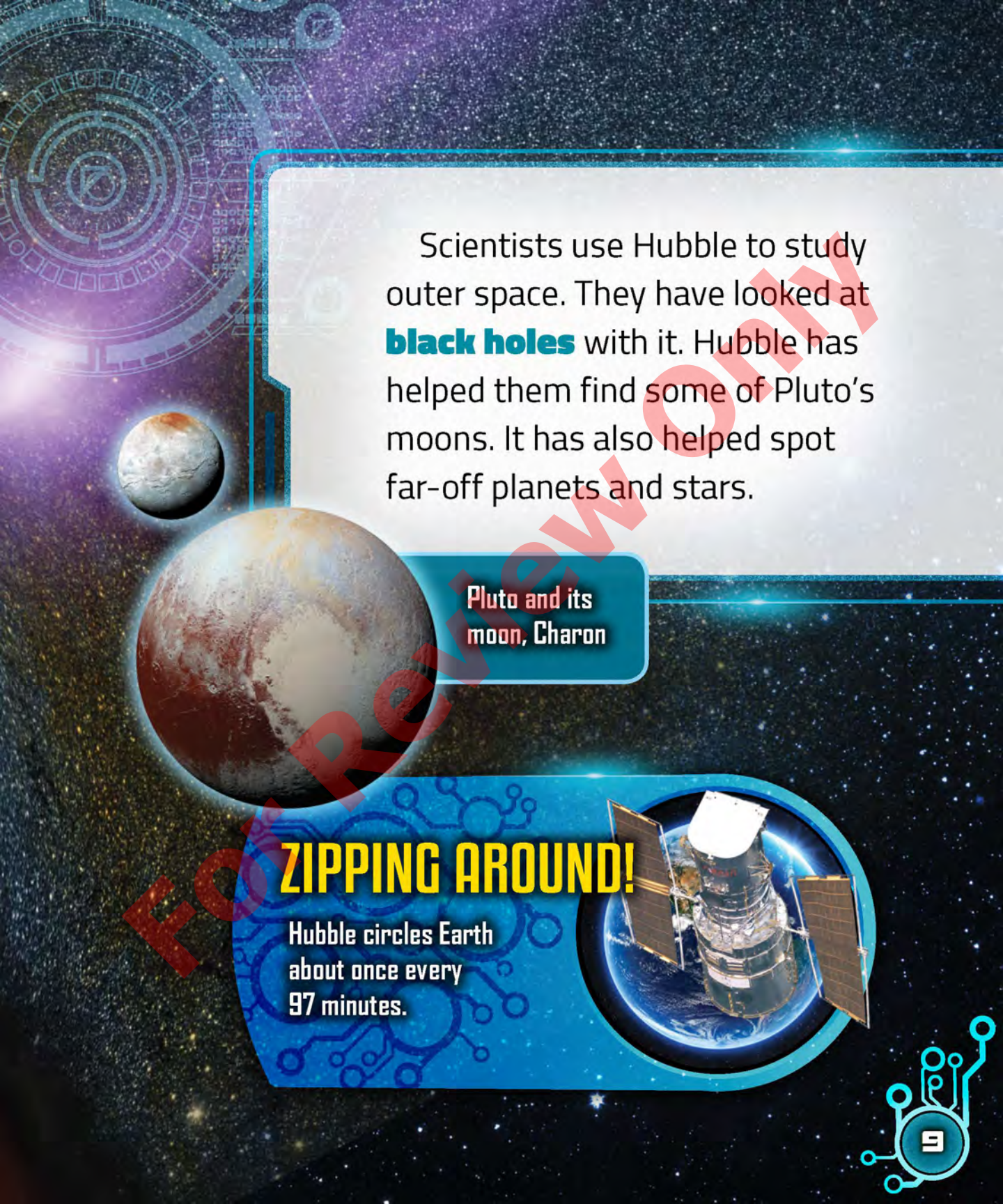


Hubble image
