What Makes an Amphibian?

cold-blooded

An amphibian's body temperature is determined by its environment.

skin

Amphibians have smooth, moist skin.

tail

Amphibians are born with tails; salamanders and newts keep their tails, but toads and frogs don't.

eggs

Amphibians are born from eggs.
