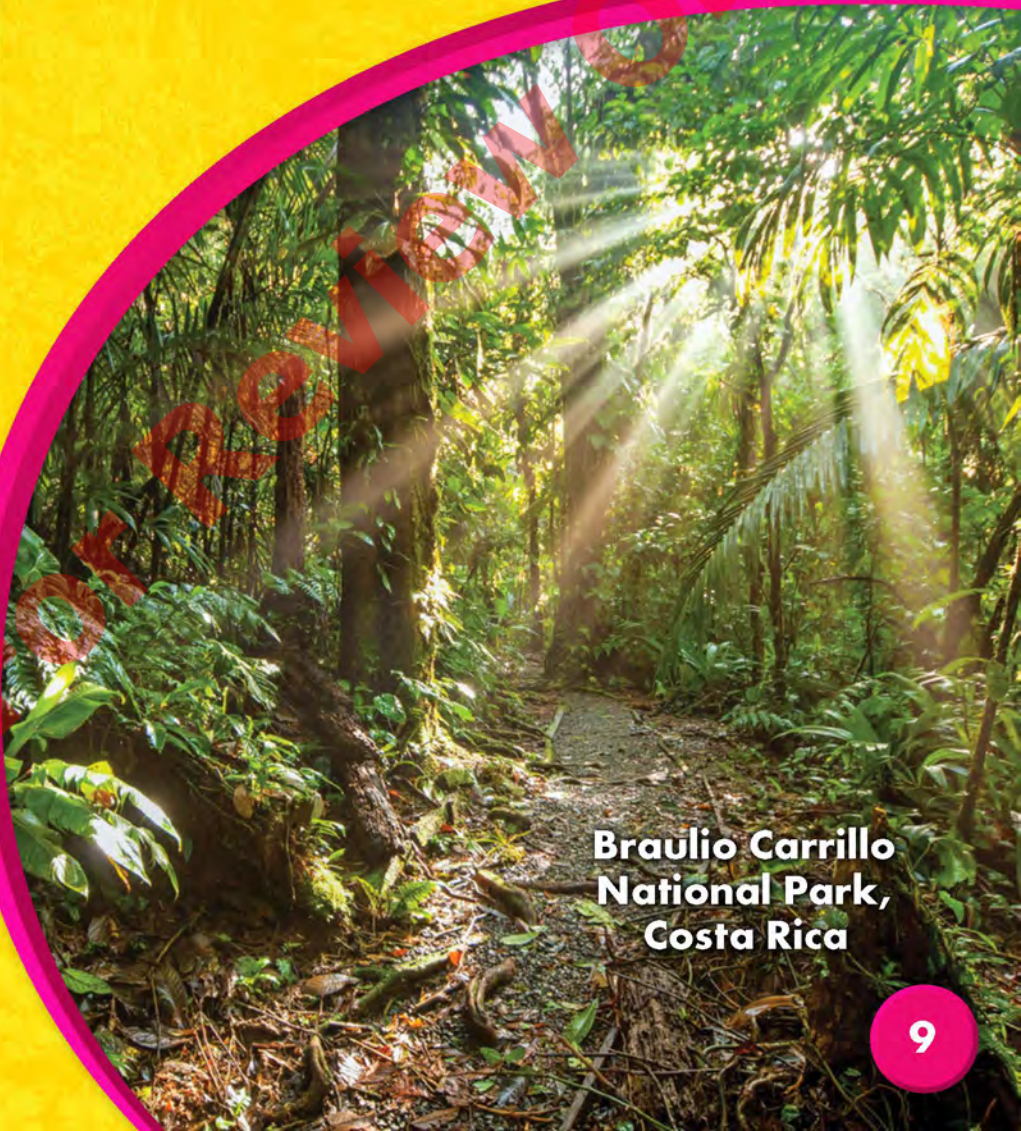


The Climate
