The Last Slice

You are at a birthday party. There is chocolate and vanilla cake. You want vanilla. But you see your friend take the last slice.

Your friend sees you are **upset**. She offers to share her slice with you. Sharing means giving part of something to someone else.



Equal Pieces

We can share in many ways. One way is by **dividing** something up. This means separating it into parts or pieces.

We divide things so there is enough for everyone. You and your friends are sharing pizza. What do you do? Cut it into **equal** slices!



Taking Turns

You can also share by taking turns. You and your friend both want to ride a bike. One of you waits while the other rides. Then you switch places.





You can share some things at the same time. You and your friend want to read the same book. Can you find a way to read it together?
