He stomped his foot.

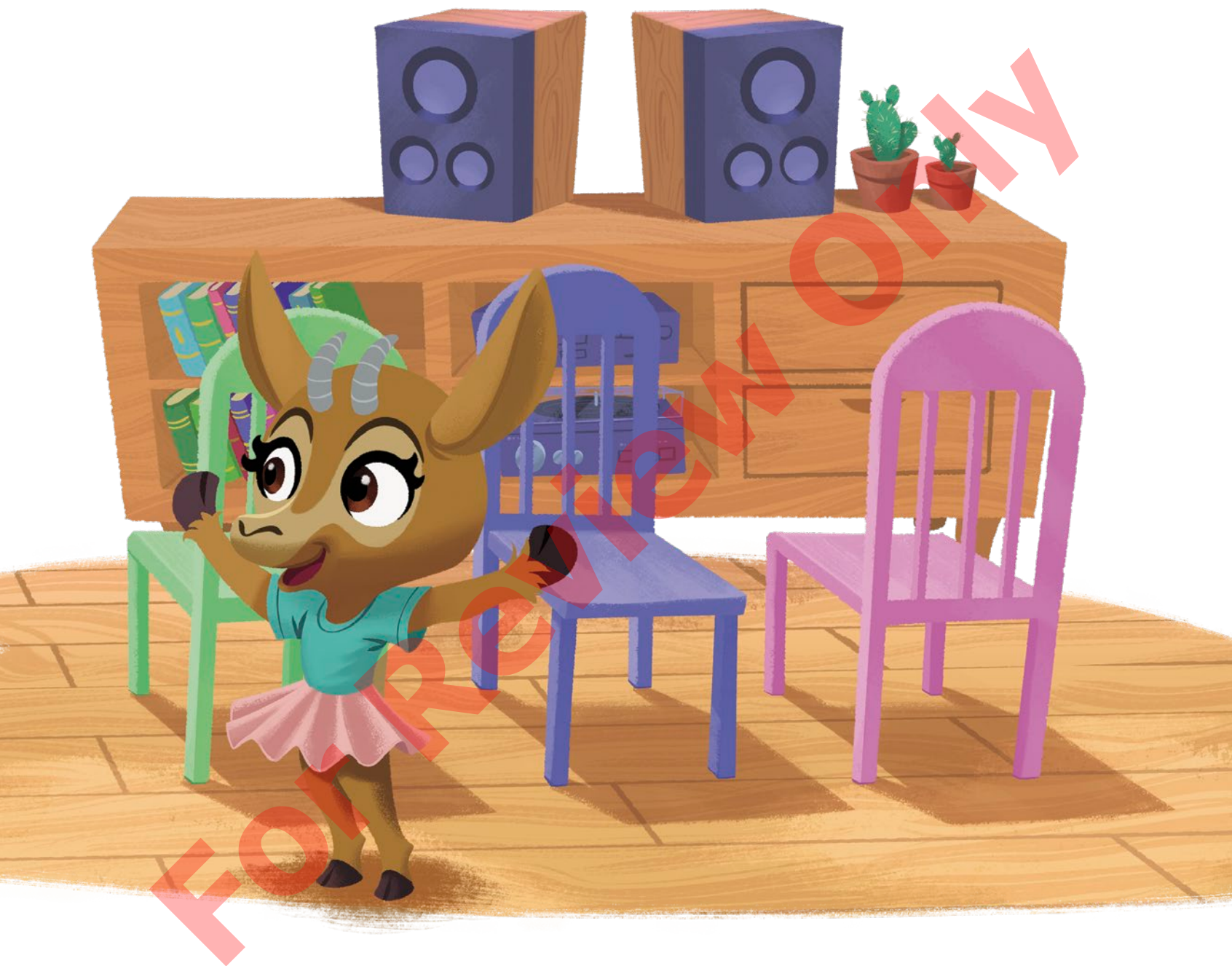


"We can after the rain passes," Toucan said.
