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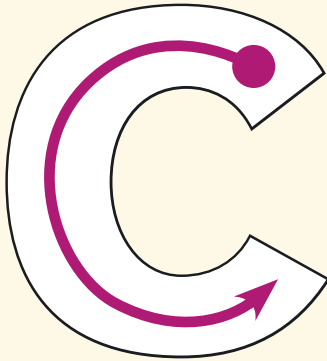
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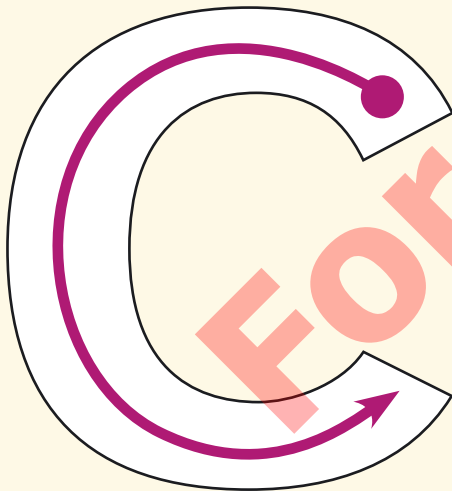
The Letter C

Tips for Reading 'I Can Get It'

Discuss all the different ways to get Mal's balloon back.

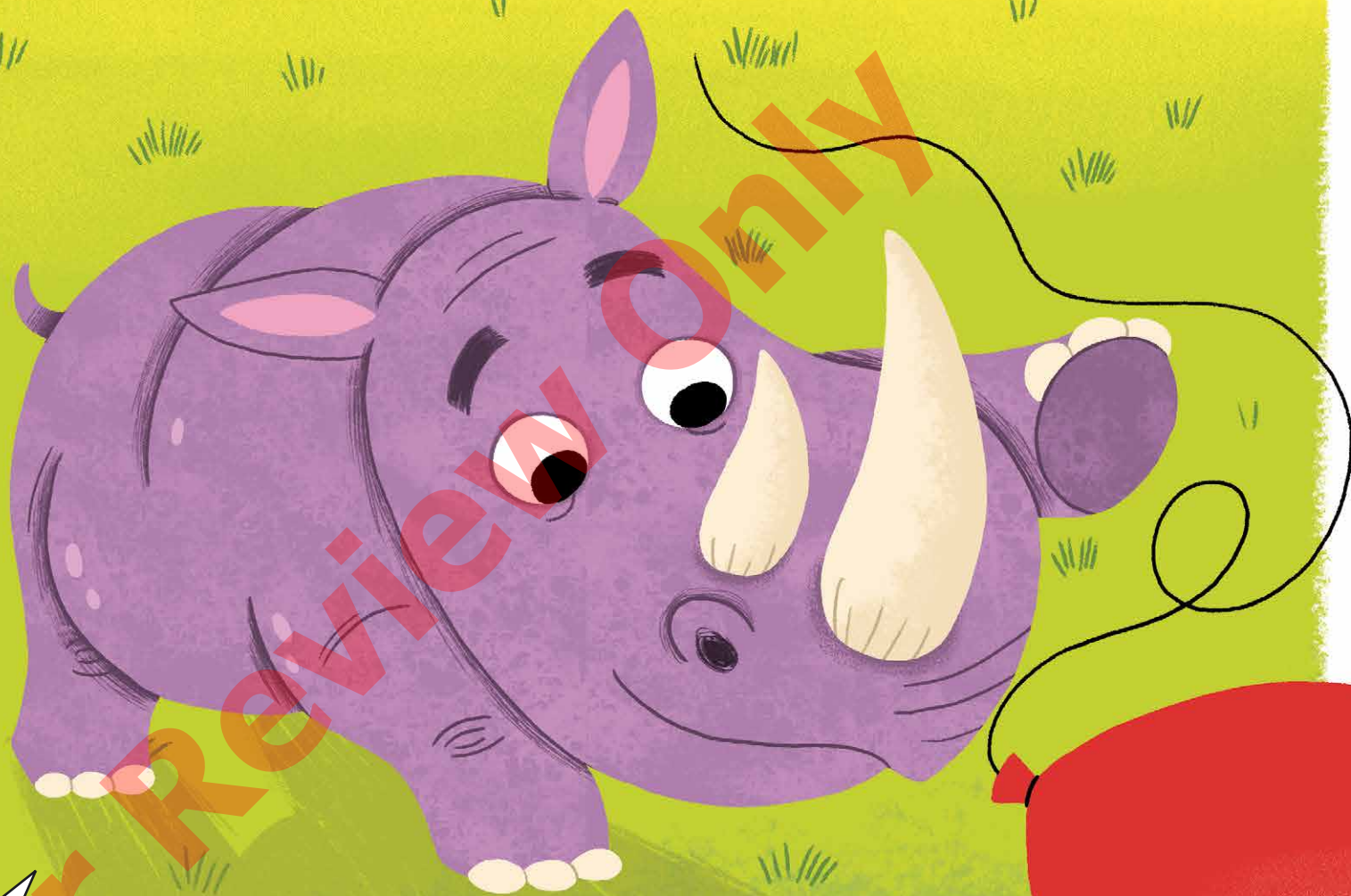
