Most words are decodable, and any non-decodable words are familiar, supported by the context and/or represented in the artwork.

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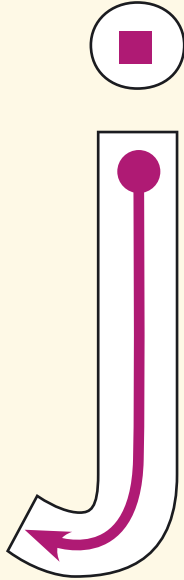
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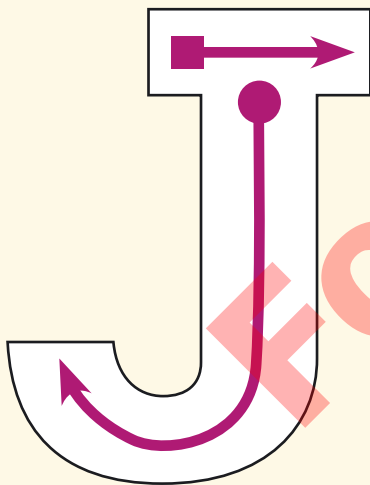
The Letter J

Tips for Reading 'Jim's Junk'

- Practise the words listed above before reading the story.
- If the reader struggles with any of the other words, ask them to look for sounds they know in the word. Encourage them to sound out the words and help them read the words if necessary.
- After reading the story, ask the reader what Jim made from all the bits of junk.
