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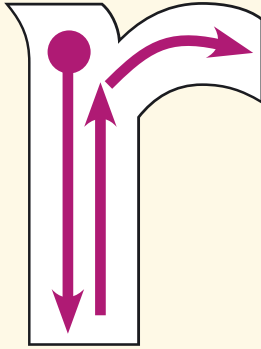
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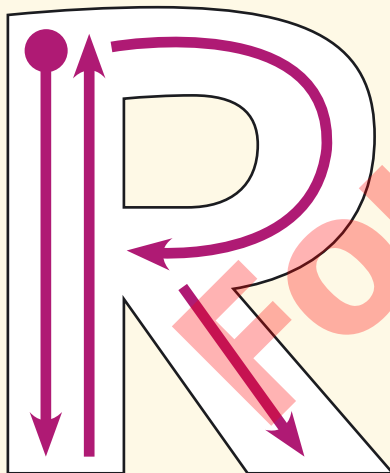
The Letter R

Tips for Reading 'Robot Rocket'

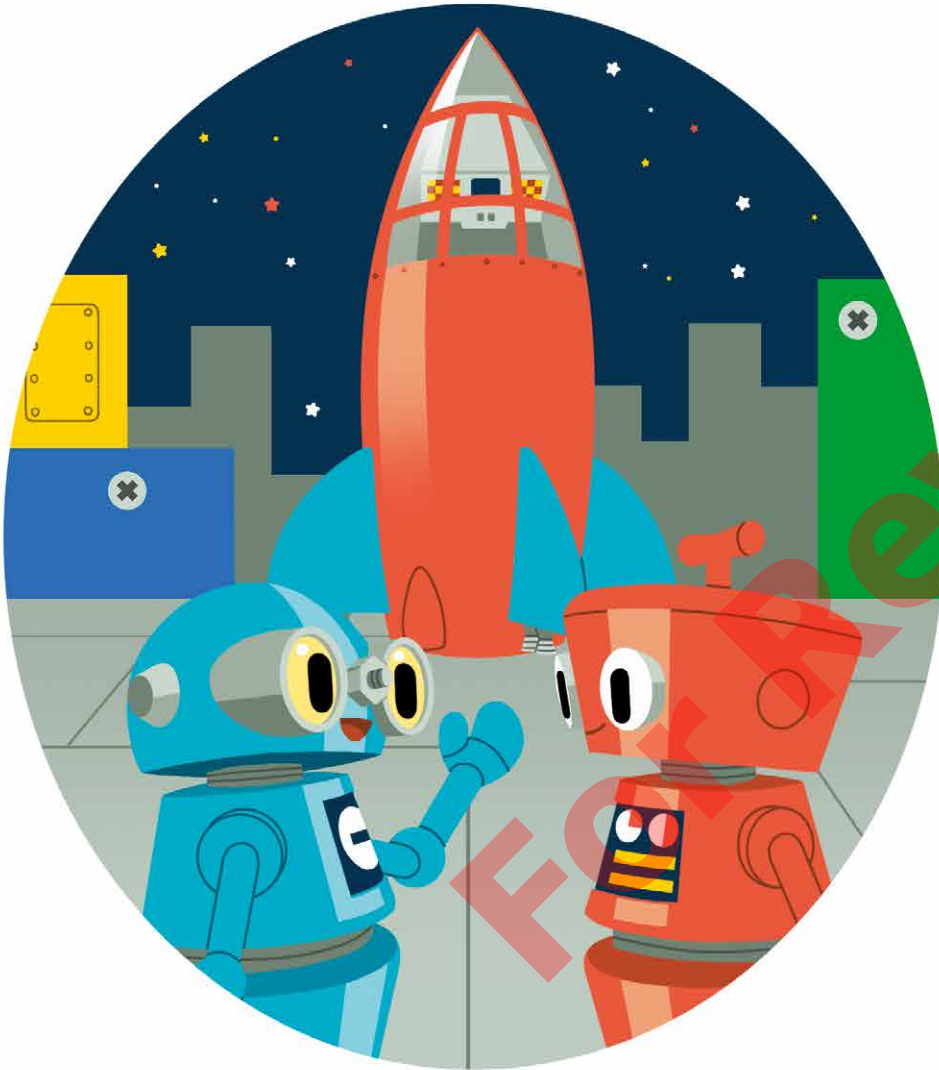
- Practise the words listed above before reading the story.

- After reading the story, ask the reader how many planets Tin and Bucket visited.

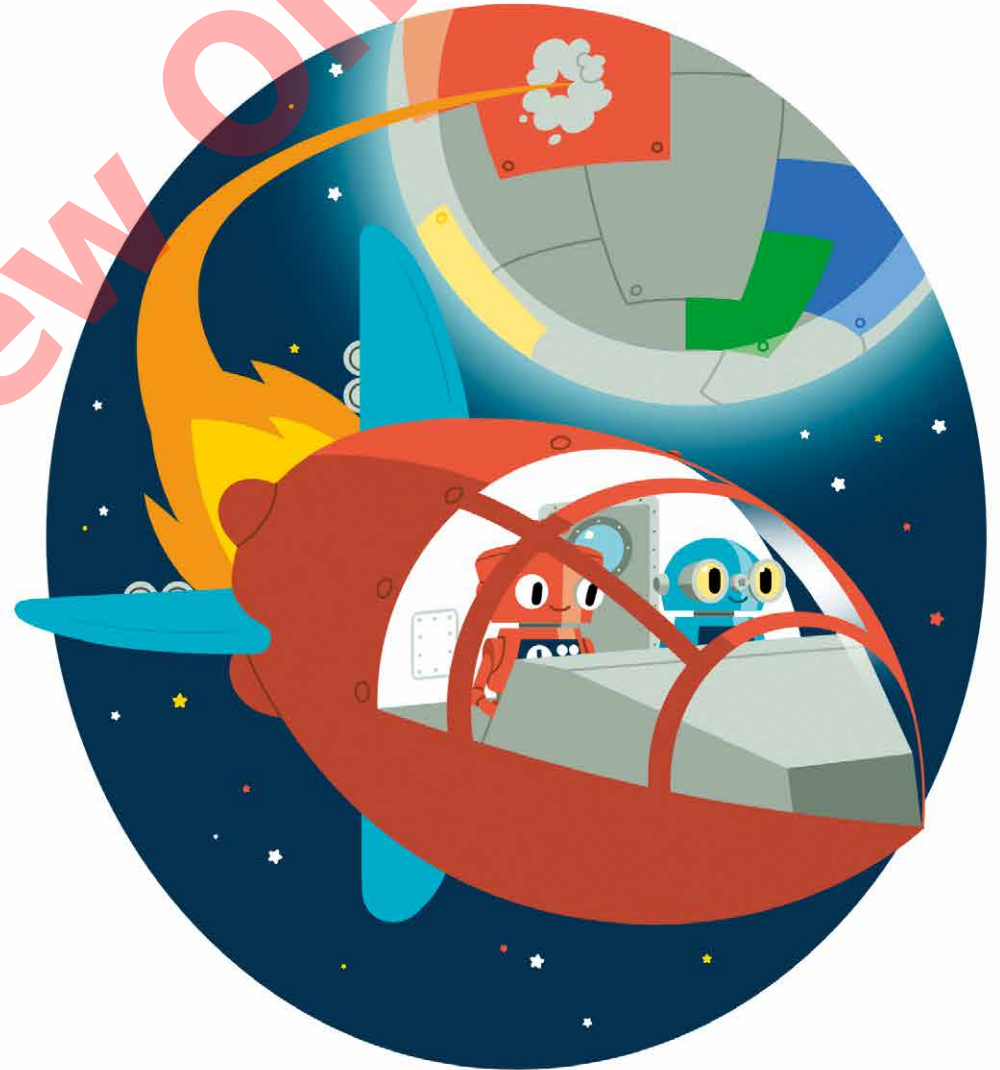

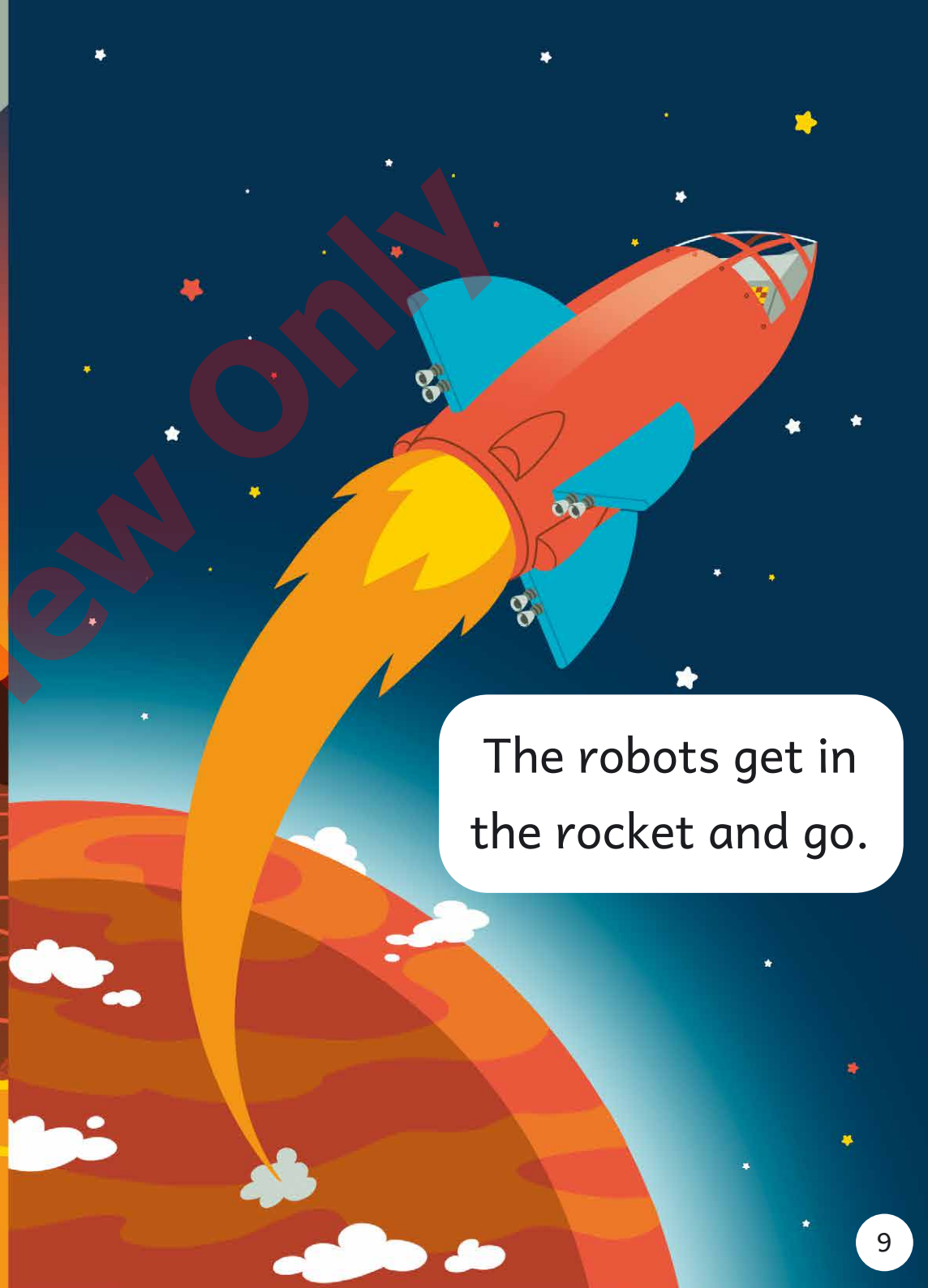
Robot Rocket
