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# How Things Are Made



Are you a creative person?



Your favorite books, movies, TV shows, and video games came from the minds of people just like you!





Movies are stories that play out on the screen. You can see them in movie theaters or at home from your own couch.



It takes a group of talented people to turn a concept into a blockbuster movie.



# Ideas and Imagination



The first step in movie making is coming up with an idea.

A movie can be funny, scary, or dramatic. It can take place in the real world or somewhere magical.



Any idea can become a movie.  
You just need a good team  
and some imagination.



# Script Writing

The next step is often to write a script. Movie writers, called screenwriters, form the story and come up with characters.

A script will often include information about the **setting**. This is where the movie takes place. The script is broken into different **scenes**.





Scripts contain descriptions of all the things that the movie's actors will do. They also have everything the actors will say. This is called dialogue.

Often, screenwriters rewrite a script many times until it is just right.
