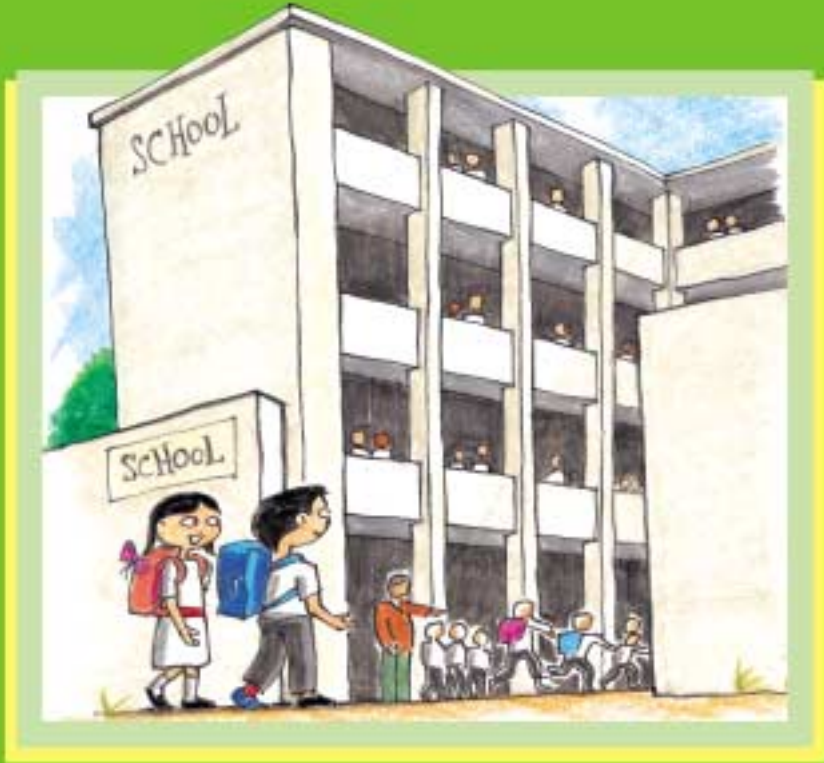


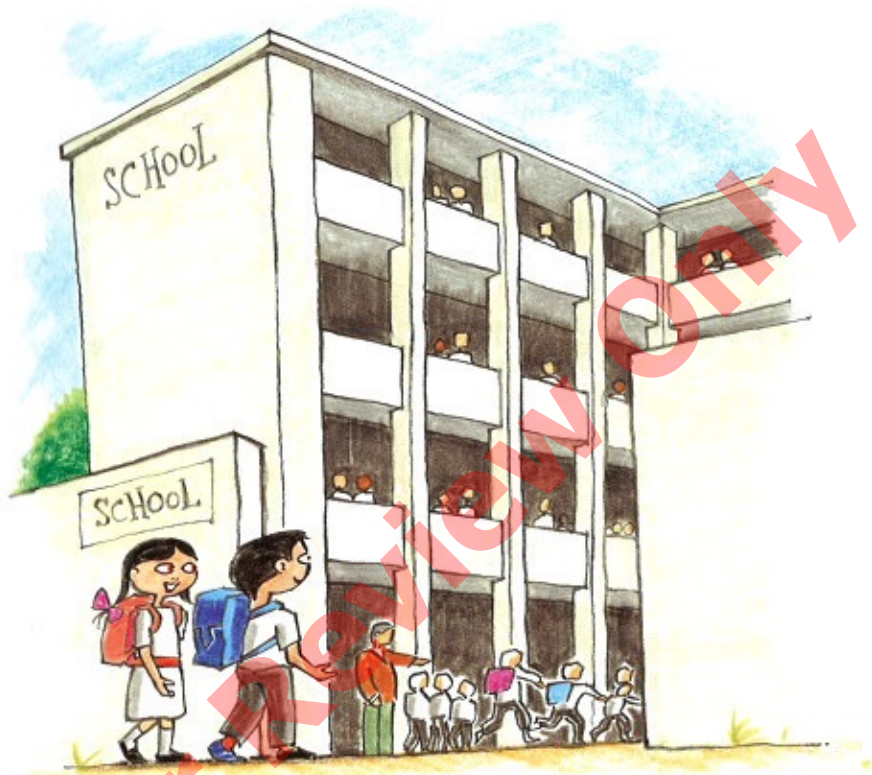
LOOK! WHAT A BIG SCHOOL!
