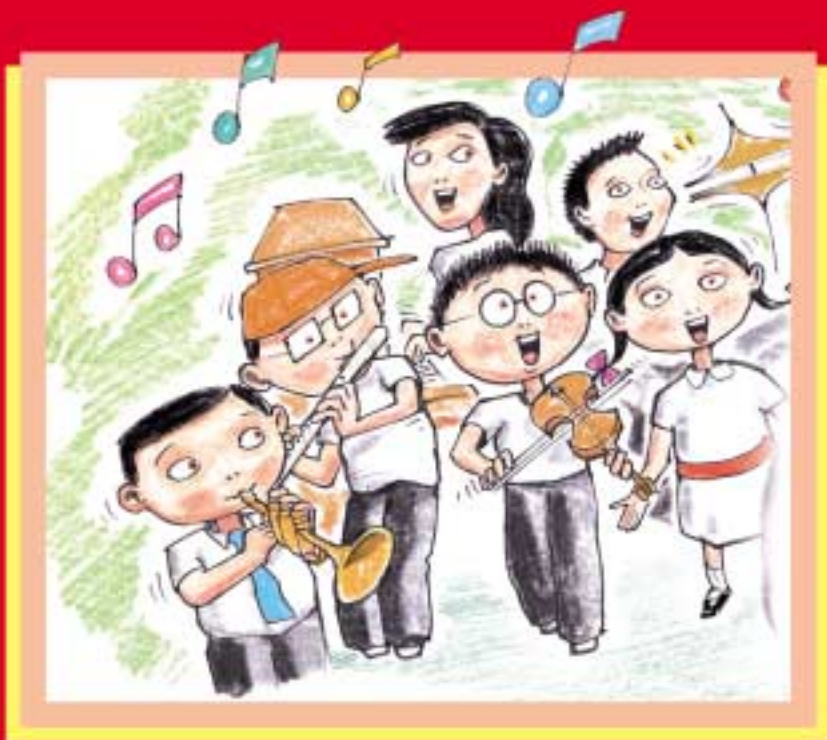


THE MUSIC CLASS
