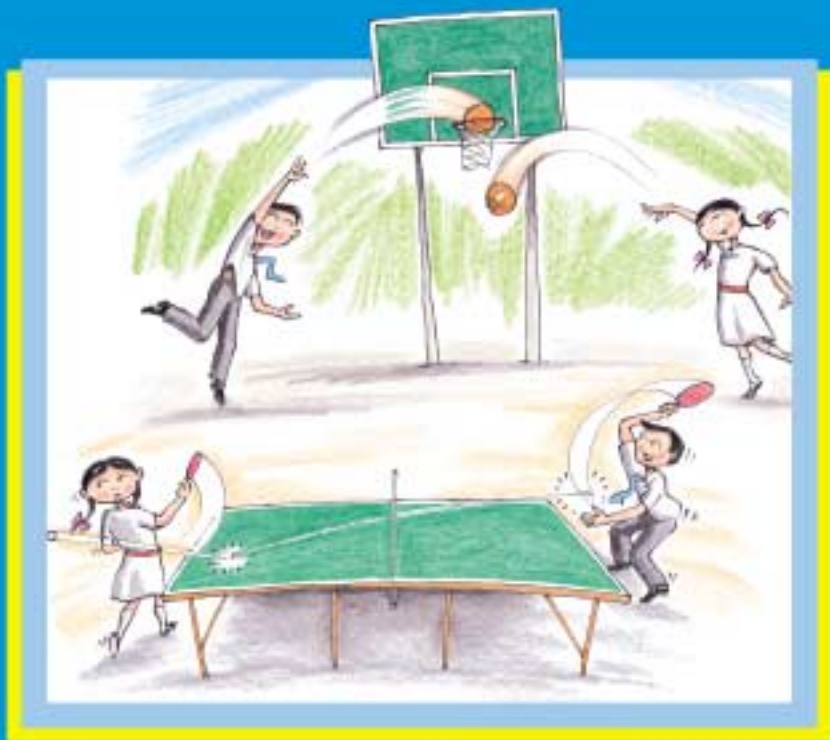


THE WINNER IS.....



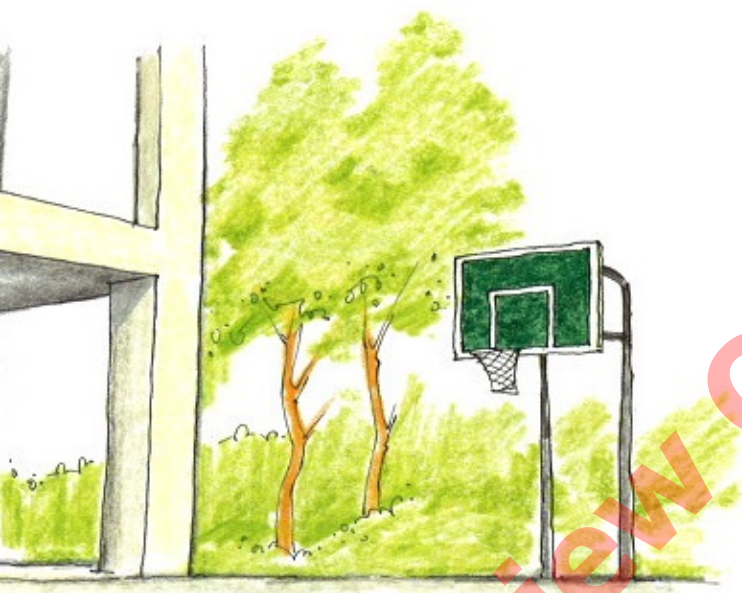

Q1. Which game do you like the best?

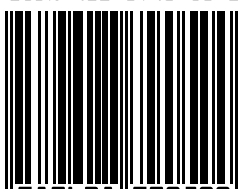
Q2. How do you feel if you lose a game?
