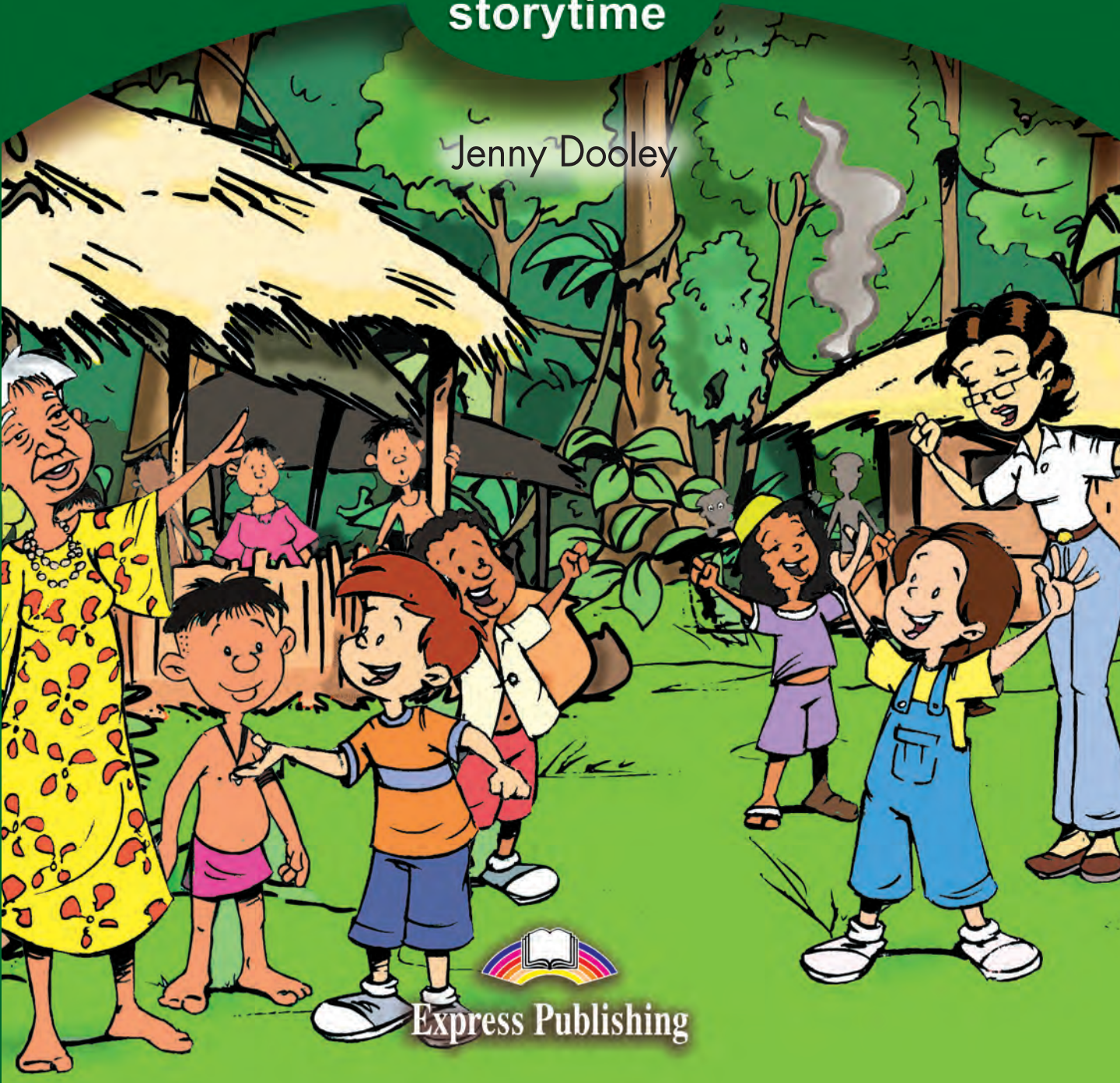

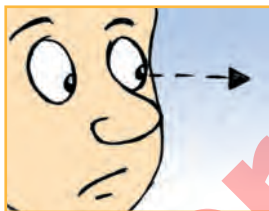

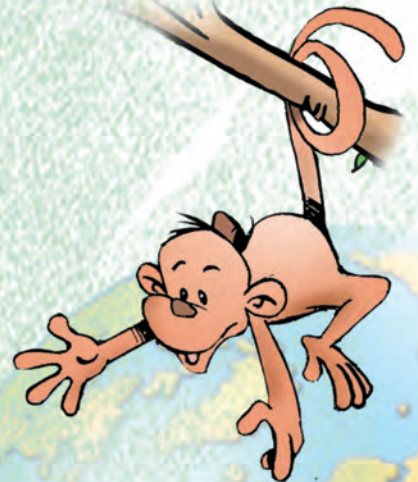
our Wonderful Planet

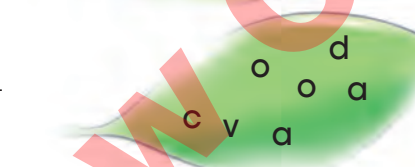
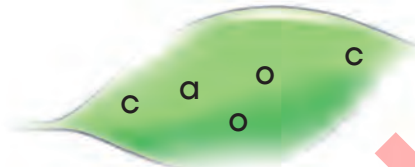
